Crucifixion - Romans 3:23

1 Thessalonians 1:5 For our gospel came not unto you in word only, but also in power, and in the Holy Ghost, and in much assurance; as ye know what manner of men we were among you for your sake.

Summarized the account of Jonah & all people in Nineveh got saved.

Explained about the use of crucifixion over the years.

Matthew 5:48 <u>Be</u> <u>ye</u> therefore <u>perfect</u>, even <u>as</u> your Father which is in heaven is <u>perfect</u>.

Acts 15:20 But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and *from* fornication, and *from* things strangled, and *from* blood.

Ezekiel 18:4 Behold, all souls are mine; as the <u>soul</u> of the father, so also the <u>soul</u> of the son is mine: the <u>soul</u> that <u>sinneth</u>, it <u>shall</u> <u>die</u>.

Romans 3:23 For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God.

Isaiah 64:6 But we are all as an unclean *thing*, and all our righteousnesses *are* as filthy rags; and we all do fade as a leaf; and our iniquities, like the wind, have taken us away.

Exodus 20:5 Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD thy God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth *generation* of them that hate me;

Romans 6:23 For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- 1 John 2:23 Whosoever denieth the Son, the same hath not the Father: (but) he that acknowledgeth the Son hath the Father also.

Mark 16:15-18 And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. 16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. 17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.

Philip explained this passage to the Ethiopian eunich.

Isaiah 53:1-12 Who hath believed our report? and to whom is the arm of the LORD revealed? 2 For he shall grow up before him as a tender plant, and as a root out of a dry ground: he hath no form nor comeliness; and when we shall see him, there is no beauty that we should desire him. 3 He is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief: and we hid as it were our faces from him; he was despised, and we

esteemed him not. 4 Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted. 5 But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed. 6 All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD hath laid on him the iniquity of us all. 7 He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth: he is brought as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, so he openeth not his mouth. 8 He was taken from prison and from judgment: and who shall declare his generation? for he was cut off out of the land of the living: for the transgression of my people was he stricken. 9 And he made his grave with the wicked, and with the rich in his death; because he had done no violence, neither was any deceit in his mouth. 10 Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise him; he hath put him to grief: when thou shalt make his soul an offering for sin, he shall see his seed, he shall prolong his days, and the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in his hand. 11 He shall see of the travail of his soul, and shall be satisfied: by his knowledge shall my righteous servant justify many; for he shall bear their iniquities. 12 Therefore will I divide him a portion with the great, and he shall divide the spoil with the strong; because he hath poured out his soul unto death: and he was numbered with the transgressors; and he bare the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors.

Summarized the account of Jesus after the Last Supper to the Cross.

Luke 23:4 Then said Pilate to the chief priests and *to* the people, I <u>find</u> <u>no</u> <u>fault</u> in this man. (Jesus)

John 19:6 When the chief priests therefore and officers saw <u>him</u>, they cried out, saying, <u>Crucify him</u>, <u>crucify him</u>. Pilate saith unto them, Take ye <u>him</u>, and <u>crucify him</u>: for I find no fault in <u>him</u>.

Mark 15:11 But the chief priests moved the people, that he should rather release <u>Barabbas</u> unto them.

John 3:13-21 - And no man hath ascended up to heaven, but He that came down from heaven, even the Son of man which is in heaven. And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of man be lifted up: That whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have eternal life. For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life. For God sent not His Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through Him might be saved. He that believeth on Him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God. And this is the condemnation, that light is

- come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil. For every one that doeth evil hateth the light, neither cometh to the light, lest his deeds should be reproved. But he that doeth truth cometh to the light, that his deeds may be made manifest, that they are wrought in God.
- John 3:7 Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.
- Acts 2:4 And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.
- Acts 2:23 Him, being delivered by the determinate counsel and foreknowledge of God, ye have taken, and by wicked hands have crucified and slain:
- Acts 22:5 As also the high <u>priest</u> doth bear me witness, and all the estate of the elders: from whom also I received letters unto the brethren, and went to <u>Damascus</u>, to bring them which were there bound unto Jerusalem, for to be punished.
- Acts 2:36 Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly, that God hath made that same Jesus, whom ye have <u>crucified</u>, both Lord & Christ.
- Matthew 17:5 While he yet spake, behold, a bright cloud overshadowed them: and behold a voice out of the cloud, which said, <u>This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased; hear ye him.</u>
- Acts 4:10 Be it known unto you all, & to all the people of Israel, that by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom ye <u>crucified</u>, whom God raised from the dead, *even* by him doth this man stand here before you whole.
- Matthew 27:25 Then answered all the people, and said, <u>His blood *be* on us,</u> and on our children.
- Romans 6:6 Knowing this, that our old man is <u>crucified</u> with *him*, that the body of sin might be destroyed, that henceforth we should not serve sin.
- Summarized of John Bunyan preaching & going in prison being wholy dedicated to the Lord.
- Mark 16:16 <u>He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved</u>; but he that believeth not shall be damned.
- 2 Corinthians 10:5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;
- 1 Timothy 2:9 In like manner also, that women <u>adorn themselves in modest</u> <u>apparel</u>, with shamefacedness and sobriety; not with broided hair, or gold, or pearls, or costly array;
- 1 Corinthians 6:19,20 What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own? 20 For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.
- 2 Corinthians 13:5 Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith; prove

- <u>your own selves</u>. Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates?
- 1 Corinthians 1:13 Is Christ divided? was Paul <u>crucified</u> for you? or were ye baptized in the name of Paul?
- 2 Corinthians 6:17 Wherefore <u>come out from among them, and be ye</u> <u>separate, saith the Lord,</u> and touch not the unclean *thing*; and I will receive you,
- 1 Corinthians 1:23 But we preach Christ <u>crucified</u>, unto the Jews a stumblingblock, and unto the Greeks foolishness;
- Acts 17:23 For as I passed by, and beheld your devotions, I found an altar with this inscription, TO THE <u>UNKNOWN</u> <u>GOD</u>. Whom therefore ye ignorantly worship, him declare I unto you.
- Hebrews 9:22 And almost all things are by the law purged with <u>blood</u>; and <u>without shedding</u> of <u>blood</u> is no remission.
- 1 Corinthians 15:4 And that he was buried, and that he <u>rose</u> again the <u>third</u> <u>day</u> according to the scriptures:
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Ephesians 6 the gospel armour referred to.
- Romans 8:13 For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live.

More service Notes:

- Matthew 20:19 And shall deliver him to the Gentiles to mock, and to scourge, and to <u>crucify</u> him: and the third day he shall rise again.
- Matthew 23:34 Wherefore, behold, I send unto you prophets, and wise men, and scribes: & *some* of them ye shall kill & <u>crucify</u>; & *some* of them shall ye scourge in your synagogues, and persecute *them* from city to city:
- Matthew 26:2 Ye know that after two days is *the feast of* the passover, and the Son of man is betrayed to be <u>crucified</u>.
- Matthew 27:22 Pilate saith unto them, What shall I do then with Jesus which is called Christ? *They* all say unto him, Let him be <u>crucified</u>.
- Matthew 27:23 And the governor said, Why, what evil hath he done? But they cried out the more, saying, Let him be <u>crucified</u>.
- Matthew 27:26 Then released he Barabbas unto them: and when he had scourged Jesus, he delivered *him* to be <u>crucified</u>.
- Matthew 27:31 And after that they had mocked him, they took the robe off from him, & put his own raiment on him, & led him away to <u>crucify</u> him.
- Matthew 27:35 And they <u>crucified</u> him, & parted his garments, casting lots: that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophet, They parted my garments among them, and upon my vesture did they cast lots.
- Matthew 27:38 Then were there two thieves crucified with him, one on the

- right hand, and another on the left.
- Matthew 27:44 The thieves also, which were <u>crucified</u> with him, cast the same in his teeth.
- Matthew 28:5 And the angel answered and said unto the women, Fear not ye: for I know that ye seek Jesus, which was <u>crucified</u>.
- Mark 15:13 And they cried out again, Crucify him.
- Mark 15:14 Then Pilate said unto them, Why, what evil hath he done? And they cried out the more exceedingly, <u>Crucify</u> him.
- Mark 15:15 And so Pilate, willing to content the people, released Barabbas unto them, and delivered Jesus, when he had scourged *him*, to be crucified.
- Mark 15:20 And when they had mocked him, they took off the purple from him, and put his own clothes on him, and led him out to <u>crucify</u> him.
- Mark 15:24 And when they had <u>crucified</u> him, they parted his garments, casting lots upon them, what every man should take.
- Mark 15:25 And it was the third hour, and they <u>crucified</u> him.
- Mark 15:27 And with him they <u>crucify</u> two thieves; the one on his right hand, and the other on his left.
- Mark 15:32 Let Christ the King of Israel descend now from the cross, that we may see & believe. And they that were <u>crucified</u> with him reviled him.
- Mark 16:6 And he saith unto them, Be not affrighted: Ye seek Jesus of Nazareth, which was <u>crucified</u>: he is risen; he is not here: behold the place where they laid him.
- Luke 23:21 But they cried, saying, Crucify him, crucify him.
- Luke 23:23 And they were instant with loud voices, requiring that he might be <u>crucified</u>. And the voices of them and of the chief priests prevailed.
- Luke 23:33 And when they were come to the place, which is called Calvary, there they <u>crucified</u> him, and the malefactors, one on the right hand, and the other on the left.
- Luke 24:7 Saying, The Son of man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men, and be <u>crucified</u>, and the third day rise again.
- Luke 24:20 And how the chief priests and our rulers delivered him to be condemned to death, and have <u>crucified</u> him.
- John 19:6 When the chief priests therefore and officers saw him, they cried out, saying, <u>Crucify</u> him, <u>crucify</u> him. Pilate saith unto them, Take ye him, and crucify him: for I find no fault in him.
- John 19:10 Then saith Pilate unto him, Speakest thou not unto me? knowest thou not that I have power to <u>crucify</u> thee, and have power to release thee?
- John 19:15 But they cried out, Away with *him*, away with *him*, <u>crucify</u> him. Pilate saith unto them, Shall I <u>crucify</u> your King? The chief priests answered, We have no king but Caesar.

- John 19:16 Then delivered he him therefore unto them to be <u>crucified</u>. And they took Jesus, and led *him* away.
- John 19:18 Where they <u>crucified</u> him, and two other with him, on either side one, and Jesus in the midst.
- John 19:20 This title then read many of the Jews: for the place where Jesus was <u>crucified</u> was nigh to the city: and it was written in Hebrew, and Greek, and Latin.
- John 19:23 Then the soldiers, when they had <u>crucified</u> Jesus, took his garments, and made four parts, to every soldier a part; and also *his* coat: now the coat was without seam, woven from the top throughout.
- John 19:32 Then came the soldiers, and brake the legs of the first, and of the other which was <u>crucified</u> with him.
- John 19:41 Now in the place where he was <u>crucified</u> there was a garden; and in the garden a new sepulchre, wherein was never man yet laid.
- 1 Corinthians 2:2 For I determined not to know any thing among you, save Jesus Christ, and him <u>crucified</u>.
- 1 Corinthians 2:8 Which none of the princes of this world knew: for had they known *it*, they would not have <u>crucified</u> the Lord of glory.
- 2 Corinthians 13:4 For though he was <u>crucified</u> through weakness, yet he liveth by the power of God. For we also are weak in him, but we shall live with him by the power of God toward you.
- Galatians 2:20 I am <u>crucified</u> with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me.
- Galatians 3:1 O foolish Galatians, who hath bewitched you, that ye should not obey the truth, before whose eyes Jesus Christ hath been evidently set forth, <u>crucified</u> among you?
- Galatians 5:24 And they that are Christ's have <u>crucified</u> the flesh with the affections and lusts.
- Galatians 6:14 But God forbid that I should glory, save in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom the world is <u>crucified</u> unto me, and I unto the world.
- Hebrews 6:6 If they shall fall away, to renew them again unto repentance; seeing they <u>crucify</u> to themselves the Son of God afresh, and put *him* to an open shame.
- Revelation 11:8 And their dead bodies *shall lie* in the street of the great city, which spiritually is called Sodom and Egypt, where also our Lord was <u>crucified</u>.
