- 1 Peter 5:8 Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring <u>lion</u>, walketh about, <u>seeking</u> whom he may <u>devour</u>:
- Exodus 12:22,23 And ye shall take a bunch of hyssop, and dip *it* in the <u>blood</u> that *is* in the bason, and strike the <u>lintel</u> and the two side posts with the <u>blood</u> that *is* in the bason; and none of you shall go out at the door of his house until the morning. 23 For the LORD will pass through to smite the Egyptians; and when he seeth the <u>blood</u> upon the <u>lintel</u>, and on the two side posts, the LORD will pass over the door, and will not suffer the destroyer to come in unto your houses to smite *you*.
- Joshua 6:17-27 And the city shall be accursed, even it, and all that are therein, to the LORD: only Rahab the harlot shall live, she and all that are with her in the house, because she hid the messengers that we sent. 18 And ye, in any wise keep *yourselves* from the accursed thing, lest ye make yourselves accursed, when ye take of the accursed thing, and make the camp of Israel a curse, and trouble it. 19 But all the silver, and gold, and vessels of brass and iron, are consecrated unto the LORD: they shall come into the treasury of the LORD. 20 So the people shouted when the priests blew with the trumpets: and it came to pass, when the people heard the sound of the trumpet, and the people shouted with a great shout, that the wall fell down flat, so that the people went up into the city, every man straight before him, and they took the city. 21 And they utterly destroyed all that was in the city, both man and woman, young and old, and ox, and sheep, and ass, with the edge of the sword. 22 But Joshua had said unto the two men that had spied out the country, Go into the harlot's house, and bring out thence the woman, and all that she hath, as ye sware unto her. 23 And the young men that were spies went in, and brought out Rahab, and her father, and her mother, and her brethren, and all that she had; and they brought out all her kindred, and left them without the camp of Israel. 24 And they burnt the city with fire, and all that was therein: only the silver, and the gold, and the vessels of brass and of iron, they put into the treasury of the house of the LORD. 25 And Joshua saved Rahab the harlot alive, and her father's household, and all that she had; and she dwelleth in Israel even unto this day; because she hid the messengers, which Joshua sent to spy out Jericho. 26 And Joshua adjured them at that time, saying, Cursed be the man

- before the LORD, that riseth up and buildeth this city Jericho: he shall lay the foundation thereof in his firstborn, and in his youngest *son* shall he set up the gates of it. 27 So the LORD was with Joshua; and his fame was *noised* throughout all the country.
- Joshua 6:17 "Now the city shall be doomed by the LORD to destruction, it and all who are in it. Only Rahab the harlot shall live, she and all who are with her in the house, because she hid the messengers that we sent.
- 1 Peter 4:17 For the time *is come* that <u>judgment</u> must <u>begin</u> at the <u>house</u> of God: and if *it* first <u>begin</u> at us, what shall the end *be* of them that obey not the gospel of God?
- 2 Chronicles 7:13,14 If I shut up heaven that there be no rain, or if I command the locusts to devour the land, or if I send pestilence among my people; 14 If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.
- Deuteronomy 18:9-14 Paraphrased When thou art come into the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not learn to do after the abominations of those nations. 10 There shall not be found among you any one that maketh his son or his daughter to pass through the fire, or that useth divination, or an observer of times, or an enchanter, or a witch, 11 Or a charmer, or a consulter with familiar spirits, or a wizard, or a necromancer. 12 For all that do these things are an abomination unto the LORD: and because of these abominations the LORD thy God doth drive them out from before thee. 13 Thou shalt be perfect with the LORD thy God. 14 For these nations, which thou shalt possess, hearkened unto observers of times, and unto diviners: but as for thee, the LORD thy God hath not suffered thee so to do.
- Genesis 18 & 19 Paraphrased of Lot in Sodom & Abram bargained the Lord to 10 righteous.
- Joshua 6:18 "And you, by all means abstain from the <u>accursed</u> things, lest you become <u>accursed</u> when you take of the <u>accursed</u> things, and make the camp of Israel <u>a curse</u>, and trouble it.
- 1 Corinthians 10:23 All things are lawful for me, but all things are <u>not</u> <u>expedient</u>: all things are lawful for me, but all things edify <u>not</u>.
- Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the <u>nurture</u> and <u>admonition</u> of the Lord.

- 1 Samuel 15:22 And Samuel said, Hath the LORD as great delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, as in obeying the voice of the LORD? Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice, and to hearken than the fat of rams.
- Romans 6:1,2 What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound? 2 God forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein?
- Acts 15:20 But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and *from* fornication, and *from* things strangled, and *from* blood.
- Joahua 7 & 8 paraphrased loosing the battle at Ai for Sin of Achin Matthew 23 Lord's woes referred to.
- 1 Timothy 2:1,2 I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men; 2 For kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty.
- Luke 18: be like the persistant widow V7 And shall not God avenge his own elect, which cry day and night unto him, though he bear long with them?
- Deuteronomy 3:26 But the LORD was wroth with me for your sakes, and would not hear me: and the LORD said unto me, Let it suffice thee; speak no more unto me of this matter.
- Numbers 20 paraphrased of account when Moses strikes rock twice & he messes up the analogy of our lord dying only once for the sins of the world.

God turned the strength of Jericho into their weakness.

- 1 Samuel 15 paraphrased V15 15 And Saul said, They have brought them from the Amalekites: for the people spared the best of the sheep and of the oxen, to sacrifice unto the LORD thy God; and the rest we have utterly destroyed.
- Joshua 6:21,22 And they utterly destroyed all that was in the city, both man and woman, young and old, ox and sheep and donkey, with the edge of the sword. 22 But Joshua had said to the two men who had spied out the country, "Go into the harlot's house, and from there bring out the woman and all that she has, as you swore to her."

God's grace poured out & Rahab was in the lineage of our Lord Jesus.

Joshua 6:23,24 And the young men who had been spies went in and brought out Rahab, her father, her mother, her brothers, <u>and all that she had</u>. So they brought out all her relatives and <u>left them outside the camp of Israel</u>.

Like Noah & family going into the Ark.

- Joshua 6:24-26 But they burned the city and all that was in it with fire. Only the silver and gold, and the vessels of bronze and iron, they put into the treasury of the house of the LORD. 25 And Joshua spared Rahab the harlot, her father's household, and all that she had. So she dwells in Israel to this day, because she hid the messengers whom Joshua sent to spy out Jericho. 26 Then Joshua charged them at that time, saying, "Cursed be the man before the LORD who rises up and builds this city Jericho; he shall lay its foundation with his firstborn, and with his youngest he shall set up its gates."
- 1 Kings 16:34 In his days did Hiel the Bethelite build Jericho: he laid the foundation thereof in Abiram his firstborn, and set up the gates thereof in his youngest son Segub, according to the word of the LORD, which he spake by Joshua the son of Nun.
- Joshua 6:27 So the LORD was with Joshua, and his fame spread throughout all the country.
- Joshua 2:9 And she said unto the men, I know that the LORD hath given you the land, and that your terror is fallen upon us, and that all the inhabitants of the land faint because of you. 10 For we have heard how the LORD dried up the water of the Red sea for you, when ye came out of Egypt; and what ye did unto the two kings of the Amorites, that were on the other side Jordan, Sihon and Og, whom ye utterly destroyed. 11 And as soon as we had heard these things, our hearts did melt, neither did

there remain any more courage in any man, because of you: for the LORD your God, he *is* God in heaven above, and in earth beneath.

Deuteronomy 18:9-14 referred to again.

- Acts 15:20 But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and from fornication, and from things strangled, and from blood.
- 1 Timothy 2:9 In like manner also, that women adorn themselves in <u>modest</u> <u>apparel</u>, with shamefacedness and sobriety; not with broided hair, or gold, or pearls, or costly array;
- 1 John 2:15 Love not the world, neither the things *that are* in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him.
- 1 Corinthians 6:19,20 What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost *which is* in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own? 20 For ye are <u>bought with a price</u>: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.
- 1 Corinthians 15:33 Be not deceived: evil communications corrupt good manners.
- Jeremiah 2:3 Israel was holiness unto the LORD, and the firstfruits of his increase: all that devour him shall offend; evil shall come upon them, saith the LORD.
- Deuteronomy 32:10 He found him in a desert land, and in the waste howling wilderness; he led him about, he instructed him, he kept him as the <u>apple of his eye</u>.
