## He Is Not Here - Mark 16

- Summarized the situation early this first day of the week.
- Mark 16:6 And he saith unto them, Be not affrighted: Ye seek Jesus of Nazareth, which was crucified: he is risen; he is not here: behold the place where they laid him.
- Matthew 12:40 For as <u>Jonas</u> was <u>three days</u> and <u>three nights</u> in the whale's belly; so shall the Son of man be <u>three days</u> and <u>three nights</u> in the heart of the earth.
- Many other raising from the dead by Elijah & Elisha.
- 2 Kings 13:21 And it came to pass, as they were burying a man, that, behold, they spied a band *of men*; and they cast the man into the sepulchre of <u>Elisha</u>: and when the man was let down, and touched the <u>bones</u> of <u>Elisha</u>, he revived, and stood up on his feet.
- John 11 Summarized the account of Lazarus raised to life. V43 And when he thus had spoken, he cried with a loud voice, <u>Lazarus</u>, <u>come forth</u>.
- Mark 15:13 And they cried out again, <u>Crucify him.</u>
- Luke 23:34 Then said Jesus, Father, <u>forgive them</u>; for they <u>know not</u> what they do. And they parted his raiment, and cast lots.
- John 19:30 When Jesus therefore had received the vinegar, he said, <u>It</u> <u>is</u> <u>finished</u>: and he bowed his head, and gave up the ghost.
- Luke 23:46 And when Jesus had cried with a loud voice, he said, Father, into thy hands I commend my spirit: and having said thus, he gave up the ghost.
- 1 Corinthians 15 referred to.
- Mark 16:9 Now when *Jesus* was risen early the <u>first</u> <u>day</u> of the <u>week</u>, he appeared <u>first</u> to Mary Magdalene,
- John 20:19 Then the same <u>day</u> at evening, being the <u>first day</u> of the <u>week</u>, when the doors were shut where the disciples were assembled for fear of the Jews, came Jesus and stood in the midst, and saith unto them, Peace *be* unto you.
- Matthew 28:6,7 He is not here: for he is risen, as he said. Come, see the place where the Lord lay. 7 And go quickly, and tell His disciples that He is risen from the dead; and, behold, He goeth before you into Galilee; there shall ye see Him: lo, I have told you.
- Matthew 28:13 Saying, Say ye, His <u>disciples</u> came by night, and <u>stole</u> him *away* while we slept.
- Acts 1:3 To whom also He shewed himself alive after His passion by <u>many</u> infallible proofs, being <u>seen</u> of them forty days, and speaking of the

things pertaining to the kingdom of God:

- John 21:2,4 There were together Simon Peter, and Thomas called Didymus, and Nathanael of Cana in Galilee, and the *sons* of Zebedee, and two other of his disciples. (7 witnesses fishing) 4 But when the morning was now come, Jesus stood on the shore: but the disciples knew not that it was Jesus.
- John 3:19 And this is the condemnation, that <u>light</u> is come into the world, and men loved <u>darkness</u> rather than <u>light</u>, because their deeds were evil.
- Acts 13:31 And He was <u>seen many</u> days of them which came up with Him from Galilee to Jerusalem, who are His witnesses unto the people.
- 2 Corinthians 13:1 This *is* the third *time* I am coming to you. In the mouth of two or three <u>witnesses</u> shall every word be <u>established</u>.

AV-resurrection 39, rising again 1, that should rise 1, raised to life again + 1537 1; 42

- 1) a raising up, rising (e.g. from a seat)
- 2) a rising from the dead 2a) that of Christ

- 2c) the resurrection of certain ones history who were restored to life (#Heb 11:35)

Matthew 22:23-29 The same day came to him the Sadducees, which say that there is no resurrection, and asked him, 24 Saying, Master, Moses said, If a man die, having no children, his brother shall marry his wife, and raise up seed unto his brother. 25 Now there were with us seven brethren: and the first, when he had married a wife, deceased, and, having no issue, left his wife unto his brother: 26 Likewise the second also, and the third, unto the seventh. 27 And last of all the woman died also. 28 Therefore in the resurrection whose wife shall she be of the seven? for they all had her. 29 Jesus answered and said unto them, Ye do err, not knowing the scriptures, nor the power of God.

Explained some modern religious error around today.

2 Corinthians 13:5 <u>Examine</u> yourselves, whether ye be in the <u>faith</u>; prove your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates?

Matthew 22:30-33 For <u>in the resurrection</u> they neither marry, nor are given in marriage, but are <u>as the angels of God in heaven</u>.

Some did not believe in the resurrection nor the angels, etc.

Matthew 22:31 But as touching the resurrection of the dead, have ye not read that which was spoken unto you by God, saying,

Explained false afterlife doctrines - reincarnation, transmutation, nirvana, purgatory, etc.

- Hebrews 9:27 And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:
- Matthew 22:32,33 I am the God of Abraham, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob? God is not the God of the dead, but of the living. 33 And when the multitude heard this, they were astonished at his doctrine.
- 1 Corinthians 15:12-19 Now if Christ be preached that he rose from the dead, how say some among you that there is no resurrection of the dead?
- Explained some errors about the resurrection none, or already happened, and the pre trib rapture, etc.

Revelation 19 explains the return of Jesus.

1 Corinthians 15:13 But <u>if there be no resurrection of the dead</u>, then is Christ not risen:

Referred to the women seeing the risen Lord.

- Matthew 28:9 And as they (Mary & women) went to tell His disciples, behold, Jesus met them, saying, All hail. And they came and held him by the feet, and worshipped him.
- 1 Corinthians 15:14-17 And if Christ be not risen, then is our preaching vain, and your faith is also vain. 15 Yea, and we are found false witnesses of God; because we have testified of God that he raised up Christ: whom he raised not up, if so be that the dead rise not. 16 For if the dead rise not, then is not Christ raised: 17 And if Christ be not raised, your faith is vain; ye are yet in your sins.
- Jesus died to pay the penalty for sins by His blood. 1 John 1:7 But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin.
- 1 Corinthians 15:18,19 Then they also which are fallen asleep in Christ are perished. 19 If in this life only we have hope in Christ, we are of all men most miserable.
- Hebrews 7:25 Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing he <u>ever</u> liveth to make <u>intercession</u> for them.
- Revelation 20:1-4 And I saw an angel come down from heaven, having the key of the bottomless pit and a great chain in his hand. 2 And he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent, which is the Devil, and Satan, and bound him a thousand years, 3 And cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal upon him, that he should deceive the nations no more, till the thousand years should be fulfilled: and after that he must be loosed a little season. 4 And I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and judgment was given unto them: and I saw the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Jesus, and for the word of God, and which had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, neither had received his

- mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands; and they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years.
- This proves there is NO pre trib rapture.
- Revelation 12:11 And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death.
- Revelation 20:5,6 But the rest of the dead lived not again until the thousand years were finished. This is the <u>first resurrection</u>. 6 Blessed and holy is he that hath part in the first resurrection: on such the second death hath no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with him a thousand years.
- Revelation 20:12,15 And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is *the book* of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works. 15 And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.
- Hebrews 9:27 And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:
- Joshua 6:18 And ye, in any wise keep *yourselves* from the accursed thing, lest ye make *yourselves* accursed, when ye take of the accursed thing, and make the camp of Israel a curse, and trouble it.
- John 5:29 And shall come forth; they that have done good, unto the <u>resurrection</u> of life; and they that have done evil, unto the <u>resurrection</u> of damnation.
- John 11:25 Jesus said unto her, I am the <u>resurrection</u>, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live:
- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.
- Acts 1:22 Beginning from the baptism of John, unto that same day that he was taken up from us, must one be ordained to be a witness with us of his <u>resurrection</u>.
- Acts 2:31 He seeing this before spake of the <u>resurrection</u> of Christ, that His soul was not left in hell, neither his flesh did see corruption.
- John 14:30 Hereafter I will not talk much with you: for the prince of this world cometh, and <u>hath</u> <u>nothing</u> <u>in</u> me.
- Acts 4:2 Being grieved that they taught the people, and preached through Jesus the <u>resurrection</u> from the dead.
- John 15:24 If I had not done among them the works which none other man did, they had not had sin: but now have they both seen and hated both me and my Father.

- Acts 4:33 And with great power gave the apostles witness of the <u>resurrection</u> of the Lord Jesus: and great grace was upon them all.
- John 20:19 Then the same <u>day</u> at evening, being the <u>first day</u> of the <u>week</u>, when the doors were shut where the disciples were assembled for fear of the Jews, came Jesus and stood in the midst, and saith unto them, Peace *be* unto you.
- John 20:26 And after eight days again his disciples were within, and <a href="Thomas">Thomas</a> with them: then came Jesus, the doors being shut, and stood in the midst, and said, Peace be unto you. 27 Then saith he to Thomas, Reach hither thy finger, and behold my hands; and reach hither thy hand, and thrust it into my side: and be not faithless, but believing. 28 And Thomas answered and said unto him, My Lord and my God. 29 Jesus saith unto him, Thomas, because thou hast seen me, thou hast believed: blessed are they that have not seen, and yet have believed.
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Referred to Acts 16 the girl with divination spirit, Acts 13 Elymas, Acts 8 Simon Magus, etc battles with the powers of darkness.
- Acts 17:18 Then certain philosophers of the Epicureans, and of the Stoicks, encountered him. And some said, What will this babbler say? other some, He seemeth to be a setter forth of strange gods: because he preached unto them Jesus, and the <u>resurrection</u>.
- Acts 17:23 For as I passed by, and beheld your devotions, I found an altar with this inscription, TO THE <u>UNKNOWN</u> <u>GOD</u>. Whom therefore ye ignorantly worship, him declare I unto you.
- Acts 17:32 And when they heard of the <u>resurrection</u> of the dead, some mocked: and others said, We will hear thee again of this *matter*.
- Acts 23:6 But when Paul perceived that the one part were Sadducees, and the other Pharisees, he cried out in the council, Men *and* brethren, I am a Pharisee, the son of a Pharisee: of the hope and <u>resurrection</u> of the dead I am called in question.
- Acts 23:8 For the Sadducees say that there is no <u>resurrection</u>, neither angel, nor spirit: but the Pharisees confess both.
- Explained this account of setting disarray among the religious leaders.
- Acts 24:15 And have hope toward God, which they themselves also allow, that there shall be a <u>resurrection</u> of the dead, both of the just and unjust.
- Acts 24:21 Except it be for this one voice, that I cried standing among them, Touching the <u>resurrection</u> of the dead I am called in question by you this day.

- Romans 1:4 And declared *to be* the Son of God with power, according to the spirit of holiness, by the <u>resurrection</u> from the dead:
- Romans 6:5 For if we have been planted together in the likeness of his death, we shall be also *in the likeness* of *his* <u>resurrection</u>:
- Philippians 3:10 That I may know him, and the power of his <u>resurrection</u>, and the fellowship of his sufferings, being made conformable unto his death;
- Philippians 3:11 If by any means I might attain unto the <u>resurrection</u> of the dead.
- Romans 8:13 For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live.
- 1 Peter 1:16 Because it is written, Be ye holy; for I am holy.
- Matthew 5:48 <u>Be</u> <u>ye</u> therefore <u>perfect</u>, even as your Father which <u>is</u> in heaven <u>is</u> <u>perfect</u>.
- 2 Corinthians 10:5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;

- Matthew 22:23 The same day came to him the Sadducees, which say that there is no <u>resurrection</u>, and asked him,
- Matthew 22:28 Therefore in the <u>resurrection</u> whose wife shall she be of the seven? for they all had her.
- Matthew 22:30,31 For in the <u>resurrection</u> they neither marry, nor are given in marriage, but are as the angels of God in heaven. 31 But as touching the <u>resurrection</u> of the dead, have ye not read that which was spoken unto you by God, saying,
- Matthew 27:53 And came out of the graves after his <u>resurrection</u>, and went into the holy city, and appeared unto many.
- Mark 12:18 Then come unto him the Sadducees, which say there is no resurrection; and they asked him, saying,
- Mark 12:23 In the <u>resurrection</u> therefore, when they shall rise, whose wife shall she be of them? for the seven had her to wife.
- Luke 14:14 And thou shalt be blessed; for they cannot recompense thee: for thou shalt be recompensed at the <u>resurrection</u> of the just.
- Luke 20:27 Then came to *him* certain of the Sadducees, which deny that there is any <u>resurrection</u>; and they asked him,
- Luke 20:33 Therefore in the <u>resurrection</u> whose wife of them is she? for seven had her to wife.
- Luke 20:35,36 But they which shall be accounted worthy to obtain that world, and the <u>resurrection</u> from the dead, neither marry, nor are given in marriage: 36 Neither can they die any more: for they are equal unto

- the angels; and are the children of God, being the children of the resurrection.
- John 11:24 Martha saith unto him, I know that he shall rise again in the resurrection at the last day.
- 1 Corinthians 15:12,13 Now if Christ be preached that he rose from the dead, how say some among you that there is no <u>resurrection</u> of the dead? 13 But if there be no <u>resurrection</u> of the dead, then is Christ not risen:
- 1 Corinthians 15:21 For since by man *came* death, by man *came* also the resurrection of the dead.
- 1 Corinthians 15:42 So also *is* the <u>resurrection</u> of the dead. It is sown in corruption; it is raised in incorruption:
- 2 Timothy 2:18 Who concerning the truth have erred, saying that the <u>resurrection</u> is past already; and overthrow the faith of some.
- Hebrews 6:2 Of the doctrine of baptisms, and of laying on of hands, and of <u>resurrection</u> of the dead, and of eternal judgment.
- Hebrews 11:35 Women received their dead raised to life again: and others were tortured, not accepting deliverance; that they might obtain a better resurrection:
- 1 Peter 1:3 Blessed *be* the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, which according to his abundant mercy hath begotten us again unto a lively hope by the <u>resurrection</u> of Jesus Christ from the dead,
- 1 Peter 3:21 The like figure whereunto *even* baptism doth also now save us (not the putting away of the filth of the flesh, but the answer of a good conscience toward God,) by the resurrection of Jesus Christ:
- Revelation 20:5,6 But the rest of the dead lived not again until the thousand years were finished. This *is* the first <u>resurrection</u>. 6 Blessed and holy *is* he that hath part in the first <u>resurrection</u>: on such the second death hath no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with him a thousand years.
