## 389 Kneeling Down to Pray - Acts 21A

Acts 21:1-7 And it came to pass, that after we were gotten from them, and had launched, we came with a straight course unto Coos, and the day following unto Rhodes, and from thence unto Patara: 2 And finding a ship sailing over unto Phenicia, we went aboard, and set forth. 3 Now when we had discovered Cyprus, we left it on the left hand, and sailed into Syria, and landed at Tyre: for there the ship was to unlade her burden. 4 And finding disciples, we tarried there seven days: who said to Paul through the Spirit, that he should not go up to Jerusalem. 5 And when we had accomplished those days, we departed and went our way; and they all brought us on our way, with wives and children, till we were out of the city: and we kneeled down on the shore, and prayed. 6 And when we had taken our leave one of another, we took ship; and they returned home again. 7 And when we had finished our course from Tyre, we came to Ptolemais, and saluted the brethren, and abode with them one day.

Paul was saying his goodbyes to the brethren along his journey.

Acts 21:4,5 And <u>finding disciples</u>, we tarried there seven days: who said to Paul through the Spirit, that he should not go up to Jerusalem. 5 And when we had accomplished those days, we departed and went our way; and they all brought us on our way, with wives and children, till we were out of the city: and we kneeled down on the shore, and prayed.

Proverbs 8:17 I love them that love <u>me</u>; and those that <u>seek me</u> <u>early</u> shall find me.

Exodus 22:29A Thou shalt not delay *to offer* the <u>first</u> of thy ripe <u>fruits</u>, Recommend the book "The Kneeling Christian" by an unknown Christian.

- 1 Corinthians 14:26-33 How is it then, brethren? when ye come together, every one of you hath a psalm, hath a doctrine, hath a tongue, hath a revelation, hath an interpretation. Let all things be done unto edifying. 27 If any man speak in an unknown tongue, let it be by two, or at the most by three, and that by course; and let one interpret. 28 But if there be no interpreter, let him keep silence in the church; and let him speak to himself, and to God. 29 Let the prophets speak two or three, and let the other judge. 30 If any thing be revealed to another that sitteth by, let the first hold his peace. 31 For ye may all prophesy one by one, that all may learn, and all may be comforted. 32 And the spirits of the prophets are subject to the prophets. 33 For God is not the author of confusion, but of peace, as in all churches of the saints.
- 2 Corinthians 11:14,15 14 And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light. 15 Therefore *it is* no great thing if his <u>ministers</u>

- also be transformed as the <u>ministers</u> of <u>righteousness</u>; whose end shall be according to their works.
- Gal 3:1 O foolish Galatians, who hath bewitched you, that ye should not obey the truth, before whose eyes Jesus Christ hath been evidently set forth, crucified among you?
- 1 John 4:1-3 Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world. 2 Hereby know ye the Spirit of God: Every spirit that confesseth that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is of God: 3 And every spirit that confesseth not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is not of God: and this is that spirit of antichrist, whereof ye have heard that it should come; and even now already is it in the world.
- Mark 16:17,18 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- Genesis 24:11 And he made his camels to <u>kneel</u> down without the city by a well of water at the time of the evening, *even* the time that women go out to draw *water*.
- Mark 10:25 It is easier for a camel to go through the <u>eye</u> of a <u>needle</u>, than for a rich man to enter into the kingdom of God.
- 1 Kings 8:54 And it was *so*, that when Solomon had made an end of praying all this prayer and supplication unto the LORD, he arose from before the altar of the LORD, from <u>kneeling</u> on his knees with his hands spread up to heaven.
- Luke 18:10-14 Two men went up into the temple to pray; the one a Pharisee, and the other a publican. 11 The Pharisee stood and prayed thus with himself, God, I thank thee, that I am not as other men are, extortioners, unjust, adulterers, or even as this publican. 12 I fast twice in the week, I give tithes of all that I possess. 13 And the publican, standing afar off, would not lift up so much as his eyes unto heaven, but smote upon his breast, saying, God be merciful to me a sinner. 14 I tell you, this man went down to his house justified rather than the other: for every one that exalteth himself shall be abased; and he that humbleth himself shall be exalted.
- 2 Chronicles 6:13 For Solomon had made a brasen scaffold, of five cubits long, and five cubits broad, and three cubits high, and had set it in the midst of the court: and upon it he stood, and <a href="kneeled">kneeled</a> down upon his knees before all the congregation of Israel, and spread forth his hands toward heaven,
- 1 Timothy 2:8 I will therefore that men <u>pray</u> every where, <u>lifting</u> up <u>holy</u> <u>hands</u>, without wrath and doubting.

- Psalms 95:6 O come, let us worship and bow down: let us <u>kneel</u> before the LORD our maker.
- Psalms 95:1-11 O come, let us sing unto the LORD: let us make a joyful noise to the Rock of our salvation. 2 Let us come before His presence with thanksgiving, and make a joyful noise unto Him with psalms. 3 For the LORD is a great God, and a great King above all gods. 4 In His hand are the deep places of the earth: the strength of the hills is His also. 5 The sea is His, and He made it: and his hands formed the dry land. 6 O come, let us worship and bow down: let us kneel before the LORD our maker. 7 For He is our God; and we are the people of His pasture, and the sheep of His hand. To day if ye will hear His voice, 8 Harden not your heart, as in the provocation, and as in the day of temptation in the wilderness: 9 When your fathers tempted me, proved me, and saw my work. 10 Forty years long was I grieved with this generation, and said, It is a people that do err in their heart, and they have not known My ways: 11 Unto whom I sware in My wrath that they should not enter into My rest.
- Matthew 21:13 And said unto them, It is written, My <u>house</u> shall be called the house of prayer; but ye have made it a den of thieves.
- Isaiah 6:1 In the year that king Uzziah died I saw also the Lord sitting upon a throne, high and lifted up, and his train filled the temple.
- Isaiah 6:8 Also I heard the voice of the Lord, saying, Whom shall I send, and who will go for us? Then said I, Here *am* I; send me.
- Jesus & John the Baptist said Matthew 4:17 From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, <u>Repent</u>: for the <u>kingdom</u> of heaven is at hand.
- Summarized the 40 years in wilderness. Numbers 14:3,23 And wherefore hath the LORD brought us unto this land, to fall by the sword, that our wives and our children should be a prey? were it not better for us to return into Egypt? 23 Surely they shall not see the land which I sware unto their fathers, neither shall any of them that provoked me see it:
- Summarized the story of the woman & 7 brothers Mark 12:24 And Jesus answering said unto them, Do ye <u>not</u> therefore <u>err</u>, because ye <u>know not</u> the scriptures, neither the <u>power</u> of <u>God</u>?
- Daniel 6:10 Now when Daniel knew that the writing was signed, he went into his house; and his windows being open in his chamber toward Jerusalem, he <u>kneeled</u> upon his knees three times a day, and prayed, and gave thanks before his God, as he did aforetime.
- **Explained of modern persecution of Christians world wide.**
- Daniel 3:17,18 If it be so, our God whom we serve is able to deliver us from the burning fiery furnace, and he will deliver us out of thine hand, O king. 18 But if not, be it known unto thee, O king, that we will not serve thy gods, nor worship the golden image which thou hast set up.

- Matthew 17:14 And when they were come to the multitude, there came to him a *certain* man, <u>kneeling</u> down to him, and saying,
- Mark 9:7 And there was a cloud that overshadowed them: and a voice came out of the cloud, saying, This is my <u>beloved Son</u>: <u>hear</u> him.
- Mark 9:28,29 And when he was come into the house, his disciples asked him privately, Why could not we cast him out? 29 And he said unto them, This kind can come forth by nothing, but by prayer and fasting.
- Mark 1:40 And there came a leper to him, beseeching him, and <u>kneeling</u> down to him, and saying unto him, <u>lf thou wilt</u>, thou canst make me clean.
- Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.
- Mark 10:17 And when he was gone forth into the way, there came one running, and <u>kneeled</u> to him, and asked him, Good Master, what shall I do that I may inherit eternal life?
- Summarized the account of the rich young ruler.
- Mark 10:21,22 Then Jesus beholding him loved him, and said unto him, One thing thou lackest: go thy way, sell whatsoever thou hast, and give to the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come, take up the cross, and follow me. 22 And he was sad at that saying, and went away grieved: for he had great possessions.
- Luke 22:41 And he was withdrawn from them about a stone's cast, and kneeled down, and prayed,
- Summarized situation in the Garden.
- Mark 14:38 <u>Watch</u> ye and <u>pray</u>, lest ye enter into temptation. The spirit truly *is* ready, but the flesh *is* weak.
- Acts 7:60 And he <u>kneeled down</u>, and cried with a loud voice, Lord, lay not this sin to their charge. And when he had said this, he fell asleep.
- Acts 9:40 But Peter put them all forth, and <u>kneeled down, and prayed;</u> and turning *him* to the body said, Tabitha, arise. And she opened her eyes: and when she saw Peter, she sat up.
- Acts 20:36 And when he had thus spoken, he <u>kneeled down, and prayed</u> with them all.
