Tragedies From Accursed Objects - Joshua 7A

Revelation 2&3 Letters to the Churches - only 1 was commended.

Joshua 7:1-5 But the children of Israel committed a trespass in the accursed thing: for Achan, the son of Carmi, the son of Zabdi, the son of Zerah, of the tribe of Judah, took of the accursed thing: and the anger of the LORD was kindled against the children of Israel. 2 And Joshua sent men from Jericho to Ai, which is beside Bethaven, on the east side of Bethel, and spake unto them, saying, Go up and view the country. And the men went up and viewed Ai. 3 And they returned to Joshua, and said unto him, Let not all the people go up; but let about two or three thousand men go up and smite Ai; and make not all the people to labour thither; for they are but few. 4 So there went up thither of the people about three thousand men: and they fled before the men of Ai. 5 And the men of Ai smote of them about thirty and six men: for they chased them from before the gate even unto Shebarim, and smote them in the going down: wherefore the hearts of the people melted, and became as water.

Summarized the recent miraculous victory of Jericho.

- Joshua 7:1 But the children of Israel <u>committed a trespass in the accursed</u> thing: for <u>Achan</u>, the son of Carmi, the son of Zabdi, the son of Zerah, of the tribe of Judah, <u>took of the accursed thing</u>: and the <u>anger of the LORD was kindled against the children of Israel</u>.
- Sin of Adam & Eve brought sin on us all. Jesus the sinless Son of God paid the penalty for us all by shedding His blood on Calvary.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Genesis 2:17 But of the <u>tree</u> of the knowledge of <u>good</u> and <u>evil</u>, thou shalt <u>not eat</u> of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die.

Summarized the serpent tempting Eve & their sin.

Acts 5 summarized the account of Annanias & Saphira lying to the Holy Spirit.

The sin of man causes problems on them.

- No such thing as secret sin. God knows. Jesus knows. The Holy Spirit knows. All God's angels know. satan knows. All the devil's angels know.
- 1 Peter 4:17 For the time *is come* that judgment must begin at the house of God: and if *it* first *begin* at us, what shall the end *be* of them that obey not the gospel of God?
- Joshua 7:2-4 And Joshua sent men from Jericho to Ai, which is beside Bethaven, on the east side of Bethel, and spake unto them, saying, Go

- up and view the country. And the men went up and viewed Ai. (do a stratigic analysis) 3 And they returned to Joshua, and said unto him, Let not all the people go up; but let about two or three thousand men go up and smite Ai; and make not all the people to labour thither; for they are but few. 4 So there went up thither of the people about three thousand men: and they fled before the men of Ai.
- Oliver Cromwell said he wanted men that feared God not men. & that Jesus Christ was King he would not take that title, just Lord Protectorate.
- Joshua 7:5 And the men of Ai smote of them about thirty and six men: for they chased them from before the gate even unto Shebarim, and smote them in the going down: wherefore the <u>hearts of the people melted</u>, and became as water.
- General Stonewall Jackson ordered his men to not run away, but stand & counter attack.
- Judges 7 summarized of Gideon calling an army. V 23 Now therefore go to, proclaim in the ears of the people, saying, Whosoever *is* fearful and afraid, let him return and depart early from mount Gilead. And there returned of the people twenty and two thousand; and there remained ten thousand.
- Strongs #04604 ma`al *mah'- al* AV-trespass 17, transgression 6, trespassed 2, falsehood 1, grievously 1, sore 1, very 1; 29
- 1) unfaithful or treacherous act, trespass 1a) against man 1b) against God
- Deuteronomy 18:9-14 Summarized. V9 When thou art come into the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not learn to do after the abominations of those nations.
- Kurt E Koch wrote many books exposing afflictions on Believers involved with the occult. "Occult ABC" is the main book.
- Acts 15:20 But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and from fornication, and from things strangled, and from blood.
- Occult involvement especially of the pastor can open the whole church up for attack.
- Summarized the account of Balaam the soothsayer's advice to get God to curse the Isrealites.
- Revelation 2:14 But I have a few things against thee, because thou hast there them that hold the doctrine of <u>Balaam</u>, who taught Balac to cast a stumblingblock before the children of Israel, to eat things sacrificed unto idols, and to commit fornication.
- Romans 10:17 So then faith *cometh* by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.
- Numbers 25:18 For they vex you with their wiles, wherewith they have beguiled you in the matter of Peor, and in the matter of Cozbi, the daughter of a prince of Midian, their sister, which was slain in the day of

- the plague for Peor's sake.
- Proverbs has many references warning of the strange woman.
- Proverbs 7:21,22 With her much fair speech she caused him to yield, with the flattering of her lips she forced him. 22 He goeth after her straightway, as an <u>ox</u> goeth to the <u>slaughter</u>, or as a fool to the correction of the stocks;
- Exodus 4:14 And the anger of the LORD was kindled against Moses, and he said, *Is* not Aaron the Levite thy brother? I know that he can speak well. And also, behold, he cometh forth to meet thee: and when he seeth thee, he will be glad in his heart.
- Summarized account of God meeting Moses in Exodus 4:24-26 And it came to pass by the way in the inn, that the LORD met him, and sought to kill him. 25 Then Zipporah took a sharp stone, and cut off the foreskin of her son, and cast it at his feet, and said, Surely a bloody husband art thou to me. 26 So he let him go: then she said, A bloody husband thou art, because of the circumcision.
- Numbers 11:10 Then Moses heard the people weep throughout their families, every man in the door of his tent: and the anger of the LORD was kindled greatly; Moses also was displeased.
- Numbers 12:9 And the anger of the LORD was kindled against them; and he departed.
- Numbers 25:3 And Israel joined himself unto Baalpeor: and the anger of the LORD was kindled against Israel.
- Deuteronomy 6:15 (For the LORD thy God *is* a jealous God among you) lest the anger of the LORD thy God be kindled against thee, and destroy thee from off the face of the earth.
- God dealt with Isreal 10 times in the wilderness & Moses interceeded for them.
- Deuteronomy 7:4 For they will turn away thy son from following me, that they may serve other gods: so will the <u>anger of the LORD be kindled against you, and destroy thee suddenly</u>.
- Deuteronomy 29:20 The LORD will not spare him, but then the anger of the LORD and his jealousy shall smoke against that man, and all the curses that are written in this book shall lie upon him, and the LORD shall blot out his name from under heaven.
- 1 Corinthians 6:19,20 What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost *which is* in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own? 20 For ye are <u>bought</u> <u>with</u> a <u>price</u>: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.
- Numbers 5:15-31 Summarised about the spirit of jealousy coming on a man.
- Deuteronomy 29:27 And the anger of the LORD was kindled against this land, to bring upon it all the curses that are written in this book:

- False teachings that the devil can't touch believers.
- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.
- Joshua 2:11 And as soon as we (Jericho citizens) had heard *these things*, our <u>hearts</u> did <u>melt</u>, neither did there remain any more courage in any man, because of you: for the LORD your God, he *is* God in heaven above, and in earth beneath.
- Ezekiel 22:30 And I sought for a man among them, that should make up the hedge, and <u>stand in</u> the <u>gap</u> before me for the land, that I should not destroy it: but I found none.
- 1 Samuel 17 Summarized the account of David against Goliath. V45 Then said David to the Philistine, Thou comest to me with a sword, and with a spear, and with a shield: but I come to thee in the name of the LORD of hosts, the God of the armies of Israel, whom thou hast defied. V48 And it came to pass, when the Philistine arose, and came and drew nigh to meet David, that David hasted, and ran toward the army to meet the Philistine. V51 Therefore David ran, and stood upon the Philistine, and took his sword, and drew it out of the sheath thereof, and slew him, and cut off his head therewith. And when the Philistines saw their champion was dead, they fled.
- Galatians 6:1 Brethren, <u>if a man be overtaken in a fault, ye which are spiritual, restore such an one in the spirit of meekness</u>; considering thyself, lest thou also be tempted.

More Service Notes:

- Joshua 7:1 But the children of Israel committed a trespass in the accursed thing: for Achan, the son of Carmi, the son of Zabdi, the son of Zerah, of the tribe of Judah, took of the accursed thing: and the anger of the LORD was kindled against the children of Israel.
- Joshua 23:16 When ye have transgressed the covenant of the LORD your God, which he commanded you, and have gone and served other gods, and bowed yourselves to them; then shall the anger of the LORD be kindled against you, and ye shall perish quickly from off the good land which he hath given unto you.
- Judges 2:14 And the <u>anger of the LORD</u> was hot against Israel, and he delivered them into the hands of spoilers that spoiled them, and he sold them into the hands of their enemies round about, so that they could not any longer stand before their enemies.
- Judges 2:20 And <u>the anger of the LORD</u> was hot against Israel; and he said, Because that this people hath transgressed my covenant which I commanded their fathers, and have not hearkened unto my voice;
- Judges 3:8 Therefore the anger of the LORD was hot against Israel, and he

- sold them into the hand of Chushanrishathaim king of Mesopotamia: and the children of Israel served Chushanrishathaim eight years.
- Judges 10:7 And <u>the anger of the LORD</u> was hot against Israel, and he sold them into the hands of the Philistines, and into the hands of the children of Ammon.
- 2 Samuel 6:7 And the anger of the LORD was kindled against Uzzah; and God smote him there for *his* error; and there he died by the ark of God.
- 2 Samuel 24:1 And again the <u>anger of the LORD</u> was kindled against Israel, and he moved David against them to say, Go, number Israel and Judah.
- 2 Kings 13:3 And <u>the anger of the LORD</u> was kindled against Israel, and he delivered them into the hand of Hazael king of Syria, and into the hand of Benhadad the son of Hazael, all *their* days.
- 2 Kings 24:20 For through the anger of the LORD it came to pass in Jerusalem and Judah, until he had cast them out from his presence, that Zedekiah rebelled against the king of Babylon.
- 1 Chronicles 13:10 And the anger of the LORD was kindled against Uzza, and he smote him, because he put his hand to the ark: and there he died before God.
- 2 Chronicles 25:15 Wherefore the anger of the LORD was kindled against Amaziah, and he sent unto him a prophet, which said unto him, Why hast thou sought after the gods of the people, which could not deliver their own people out of thine hand?
- Isaiah 5:25 Therefore is the anger of the LORD kindled against his people, and he hath stretched forth his hand against them, and hath smitten them: and the hills did tremble, and their carcases were torn in the midst of the streets. For all this his anger is not turned away, but his hand is stretched out still.
- Jeremiah 23:20 <u>The anger of the LORD</u> shall not return, until he have executed, and till he have performed the thoughts of his heart: in the latter days ye shall consider it perfectly.
- Jeremiah 52:3 For through <u>the anger of the LORD</u> it came to pass in Jerusalem and Judah, till he had cast them out from his presence, that Zedekiah rebelled against the king of Babylon.
- Lamentations 4:16 <u>The anger of the LORD</u> hath divided them; he will no more regard them: they respected not the persons of the priests, they favoured not the elders.
- Joshua 7:5 And the men of Ai smote of them about thirty and six men: for they chased them *from* before the gate *even* unto Shebarim, and smote them in the going down: wherefore the <u>hearts</u> of the people <u>melted</u>, and became as water.
- Joshua 14:8 Nevertheless my brethren that went up with me made the <u>heart</u> of the people <u>melt</u>: but I wholly followed the LORD my God.

- 2 Samuel 17:10 And he also *that is* valiant, whose <u>heart</u> *is* as the <u>heart</u> of a lion, shall utterly <u>melt</u>: for all Israel knoweth that thy father *is* a mighty man, and *they* which *be* with him *are* valiant men.
- Psalms 22:14 I am poured out like water, and all my bones are out of joint: my <u>heart</u> is like wax; it is <u>melted</u> in the midst of my bowels.
- Isaiah 13:7 Therefore shall all hands be faint, and every man's <u>heart</u> shall melt:
- Isaiah 19:1 The burden of Egypt. Behold, the LORD rideth upon a swift cloud, and shall come into Egypt: and the idols of Egypt shall be moved at his presence, and the heart of Egypt shall melt in the midst of it.
- Ezekiel 21:7 And it shall be, when they say unto thee, Wherefore sighest thou? that thou shalt answer, For the tidings; because it cometh: and every heart shall melt, and all hands shall be feeble, and every spirit shall faint, and all knees shall be weak as water: behold, it cometh, and shall be brought to pass, saith the Lord GOD.
- Nahum 2:10 She is empty, and void, and waste: and the <u>heart melteth</u>, and the knees smite together, and much pain *is* in all loins, and the faces of them all gather blackness.
- Galatians 6:2-10 Bear ye one another's burdens, and so fulfil the law of Christ. 3 For if a man think himself to be something, when he is nothing, he deceiveth himself. 4 But let every man prove his own work, and then shall he have rejoicing in himself alone, and not in another. 5 For every man shall bear his own burden. 6 Let him that is taught in the word communicate unto him that teacheth in all good things. 7 Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap. 8 For he that soweth to his flesh shall of the flesh reap corruption; but he that soweth to the Spirit shall of the Spirit reap life everlasting. 9 And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not. 10 As we have therefore opportunity, let us do good unto all men, especially unto them who are of the household of faith.
