## **The Spirit of Zeal - Psalms 69**

- Psalms 69:9 For the zeal of thine house hath eaten me up; and the reproaches of them that reproached thee are fallen upon me.
- John 2:17 And his disciples remembered that it was written, The zeal of thine house hath eaten me up.
- Many of God's Leaders had Godly zeal. Mark 6:18 For John had said unto Herod, It is not lawful for thee to have thy brother's wife.
- Eastons Bible Dictionary Zealots A sect of Jews which originated with Judas the Gaulonite #Acts 5:37 They refused to pay tribute to the Romans, on the ground that this was a violation of the principle that God was the only king of Israel. They rebelled against the Romans, but were soon scattered, and became a lawless band of mere brigands. They were after called Sicarii, from their use of the sica, the Roman dagger.
- Acts 5:37 After this man rose up Judas of Galilee in the days of the taxing, and drew away much people after him: he also perished; and all, *even* as many as obeyed him, were dispersed.

- Exodus 20:5 Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for <u>I</u> the <u>LORD</u> thy <u>God</u> <u>am</u> a <u>jealous God</u>, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children to the third & fourth <u>generation</u> of them that hate me;
- Numbers 25:11 Phinehas, the son of Eleazar, the son of Aaron the priest, hath turned My wrath away from the children of Israel, while he was <u>zealous for My sake</u> among them, that I consumed not the children of Israel in My jealousy.
- Revelation 2:14 But I have a few things against thee, because thou hast there them that hold the doctrine of <u>Balaam</u>, who taught Balac to cast a stumblingblock before the children of Israel, to eat things sacrificed unto idols, and to commit fornication.
- Numbers 25:13 And he shall have it, and his seed after him, *even* the covenant of an everlasting priesthood; because he was <u>zealous for his</u> God, and made an atonement for the children of Israel.
- 2 Samuel 21:2,6 And the king called the Gibeonites, and said unto them; (now the Gibeonites were not of the children of Israel, but of the remnant of the Amorites; and the children of Israel had sworn unto them: and Saul sought to slay them in his zeal to the children of Israel and Judah.) 6 Let seven men of his sons be delivered unto us, and we

- will hang them up unto the LORD in Gibeah of Saul, whom the LORD did choose. And the king said, I will give them.
- 2 Kings 10:16 And he (Jehu) said, Come with me, and see my <u>zeal</u> for the LORD. So they made him ride in his chariot.
- John 8:11 She said, No man, Lord. And Jesus said unto her, Neither do I condemn thee: go, and sin no more.
- Matthew 26:52 Then said Jesus unto him, <u>Put up</u> again <u>thy sword</u> into his place: for all they that take the <u>sword</u> shall perish with the <u>sword</u>.
- 2 Kings 19:31 For out of Jerusalem shall go forth a remnant, and they that escape out of mount Zion: the <u>zeal of the LORD</u> of hosts shall do this.
- Psalms 69:9 For the <u>zeal of thine house</u> hath eaten me up; and the reproaches of them that reproached thee are fallen upon me.
- Psalms 119:139 My <u>zeal</u> hath consumed me, because mine enemies have <u>forgotten Thy words</u>.
- Isaiah 9:7 Of the increase of *his* government and peace *there shall be* no end, upon the throne of David, and upon his kingdom, to order it, and to establish it with judgment and with justice from henceforth even for ever. The <u>zeal of the LORD of hosts</u> will perform this.
- John 4:6 Now Jacob's well was there. Jesus therefore, being wearied with *his* journey, sat thus on the well: *and* it was about the sixth hour.
- Matthew 25:21 & 23 His lord said unto him, <u>Well done</u>, <u>thou</u> good and <u>faithful servant</u>: thou hast been faithful over a few things, I will make thee ruler over many things: enter thou into the joy of thy lord.
- Isaiah 37:32 For out of Jerusalem shall go forth a remnant, and they that escape out of mount Zion: the <u>zeal of the LORD of hosts</u> shall do this.
- Isaiah 59:17 For he put on righteousness as a breastplate, & an helmet of salvation upon his head; & he put on the garments of vengeance *for* clothing, & was clad with zeal as a cloke. Ephesians 6 Gospel armour.
- 1 Samuel 17:48 And it came to pass, when the Philistine arose, and came and drew nigh to meet David, that David hasted, and ran toward the army to meet the Philistine.
- Isaiah 63:15 Look down from heaven, and behold from the habitation of thy holiness & of thy glory: where *is* thy <u>zeal</u> & thy strength, the sounding of thy bowels and of thy mercies toward me? are they restrained?
- 1 John 2:1 My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not. And if any man sin, we have an <u>advocate</u> with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous:
- Ezekiel 5:13 Thus shall mine anger be accomplished, and I will cause my fury to rest upon them, and I will be comforted: and they shall know that I the LORD have spoken *it* in My zeal, when I have accomplished my fury in them.
- 1 Peter 4:17 For the time is come that judgment must begin at the house of

God: and if *it* first <u>begin</u> at us, what shall the end <u>be</u> of them that obey not the gospel of God?

- John 2:17 And His disciples remembered that it was written, The <u>zeal of</u> thine house hath eaten me up.
- John 2:15,16 And when he had made a scourge of small cords, he drove them all out of the temple, and the sheep, and the oxen; and poured out the changers' money, and overthrew the tables; 16 And said unto them that sold doves, Take these things hence; make not my Father's house an house of merchandise.
- Mark 11:17 And he taught, saying unto them, Is it not written, My house shall be called of all nations the house of prayer? but ye have made it a den of thieves.
- Matthew 10:37He that loves father or mother more than me is not worthy of me: & he that loves son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me.
- Acts 21:20 And when they heard *it*, they glorified the Lord, and said unto him, Thou seest, brother, how many thousands of Jews there are which believe; and they are all <u>zealous of the law</u>:
- Deuteronomy 18:9-14 When thou art come into the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not learn to do after the abominations of those nations. 10 There shall not be found among you any one that maketh his son or his daughter to pass through the fire, or that useth divination, or an observer of times, or an enchanter, or a witch, 11 Or a charmer, or a consulter with familiar spirits, or a wizard, or a necromancer. 12 For all that do these things are an abomination unto the LORD: and because of these abominations the LORD thy God doth drive them out from before thee. 13 Thou shalt be perfect with the LORD thy God. 14 For these nations, which thou shalt possess, hearkened unto observers of times, and unto diviners: but as for thee, the LORD thy God hath not suffered thee so to do.
- Acts 15:20 But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and *from* fornication, and *from* things strangled, and *from* blood.
- Acts 22:3 I am verily a man which am a Jew, born in Tarsus, a city in Cilicia, yet brought up in this city at the feet of Gamaliel, and taught according to the perfect manner of the law of the fathers, and was <u>zealous</u> toward God, as ye all are this day.
- Acts 14:19,20 And there came thither certain Jews from Antioch and

- Iconium, who persuaded the people, and, having <u>stoned</u> Paul, drew <u>him</u> <u>out</u> of the city, supposing he had been dead. 20 Howbeit, as the disciples stood round about him, he rose up, and came into the city: and the next day he departed with Barnabas to Derbe.
- 2 Timothy 1:7 For God hath not given us the <u>spirit</u> of <u>fear</u>; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.
- Luke 9:54,55 And when his disciples James and John saw *this*, they said, Lord, wilt thou that we command fire to come down from heaven, and consume them, even as Elias did? 55 But he turned, and rebuked them, and said, <u>Ye</u> know not what <u>manner</u> of <u>spirit ye are</u> of.
- John 20:27 Then saith he to Thomas, Reach hither thy finger, and behold my hands; and reach hither thy hand, and thrust *it* into my side: and be not faithless, but believing.
- Mark 16:14 Afterward he appeared unto the eleven as they sat at meat, and upbraided them with their unbelief and hardness of heart, because they believed not them which had seen him after he was risen.
- Romans 10:2 For I bear them record that they have a <u>zeal of God</u>, but not according to knowledge.
- 1 Corinthians 14:12 Even so ye, forasmuch as ye are <u>zealous</u> of spiritual *gifts*, seek that ye may excel to the edifying of the church.
- 1 Corinthians 16:15 I beseech you, brethren, (ye know the house of Stephanas, that it is the firstfruits of Achaia, and *that* they have <u>addicted</u> themselves to the <u>ministry</u> of the <u>saints</u>,)
- 2 Corinthians 7:11 For behold this selfsame thing, that ye sorrowed after a godly sort, what carefulness it wrought in you, yea, what clearing of yourselves, yea, what indignation, yea, what fear, yea, what vehement desire, yea, what zeal, yea, what revenge! In all things ye have approved yourselves to be clear in this matter.
- 2 Corinthians 9:2 For I know the forwardness of your mind, for which I boast of you to them of Macedonia, that Achaia was ready a year ago; and <u>your zeal hath provoked</u> very many.
- Galatians 1:14 And profited in the Jews' religion above many my equals in mine own nation, being more exceedingly zealous of the traditions of my fathers.
- Luke 6:15Matthew, Thomas, James the son of Alphaeus, & Simon Zelotes,
- Galatians 4:17 They <u>zealously affect you, but not well;</u> yea, they would exclude you, that ye might affect them.
- Galatians 4:18 But *it is* good to be zealously affected always in <u>a good</u> thing, and not only when I am present with you.
- Philippians 3:6 <u>Concerning zeal, persecuting the church</u>; touching the righteousness which is in the law, blameless.
- Colossians 4:13 For I bear him record, that he hath a great zeal for you, and

- them that are in Laodicea, and them in Hierapolis.
- Titus 2:14 (Jesus) Who gave himself for us, that he might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto himself a peculiar people, <u>zealous of good</u> works.
- Exodus 8:1 the LORD spake unto Moses, Go unto Pharaoh, and say unto him, Thus saith the LORD, <u>Let my people go, that they may serve me</u>.
- Revelation 3:19 As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten: <u>be zealous</u> <u>therefore, and repent</u>.
- 2 Corinthians 6:2 (For he saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now *is* the accepted time; behold, now *is* the day of salvation.)
- Luke 6:15 Matthew, Thomas, James the *son* of Alphaeus, & Simon Zelotes, Acts 1:13 And when they were come in, they went up into an upper room, where abode both Peter, and James, and John, and Andrew, Philip, and Thomas, Bartholomew, and Matthew, James *the son* of Alphaeus, and Simon Zelotes, and Judas *the brother* of James.
- Revelation 3:14-22 And unto the angel of the church of the Laodiceans write; These things saith the Amen, the faithful and true witness, the beginning of the creation of God; 15 I know thy works, that thou art neither cold nor hot: I would thou wert cold or hot. 16 So then because thou art lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will spue thee out of my mouth. 17 Because thou sayest, I am rich, and increased with goods, and have need of nothing; and knowest not that thou art wretched, and miserable, and poor, and blind, and naked: 18 I counsel thee to buy of me gold tried in the fire, that thou mayest be rich; and white raiment, that thou mayest be clothed, and that the shame of thy nakedness do not appear; and anoint thine eyes with eyesalve, that thou mayest see. 19 As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten: be zealous therefore, and repent. 20 Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with Me. 21 To him that overcometh will I grant to sit with Me in My throne, even as I also overcame, and am set down with My Father in His throne. 22 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches.
