Bound By The Selling Of The Soul - Numbers 30

- Psalm 23:3A He restoreth my soul:
- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have *it* more abundantly.
- Ephesians 4:30 And grieve not the <u>Holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are</u> sealed unto the day of redemption.
- 1 Corinthians 15:33 Be not deceived: <u>evil communications corrupt good</u> manners.
- Isaiah 61:1 The Spirit of the Lord GOD *is* upon me; because the LORD hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to *them that are* bound;
- Luke 4:18,19 The Spirit of the Lord *is* upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised, 19 To preach the acceptable year of the Lord.
- John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.
- Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever. Psalm 23:3A He restoreth my soul:
- 2 Samuel 15:6 And on this manner did <u>Absalom</u> to all Israel that came to the king for judgment: so <u>Absalom</u> stole the <u>hearts</u> of the men of Israel. & Summarized how Absalom did that.
- Matthew 12:29 & Mark 3:27 No <u>man</u> can enter into a <u>strong man</u>'s house, and spoil his goods, except he will first <u>bind</u> the <u>strong man</u>; and then he will spoil his house.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Numbers 30:1-16 -
- Numbers 30:1,2 And Moses spake unto the heads of the tribes concerning the children of Israel, saying, This is the thing which the LORD hath commanded. 2 If a man vow a vow unto the LORD, or swear an oath to bind his soul with a bond; he shall not break his word, he shall do according to all that proceedeth out of his mouth.
- Numbers 30:2 (NKJV) "If a man makes a vow to the LORD, or swears an

- oath to bind himself by some agreement, he shall not break his word; he shall do according to all that proceeds out of his mouth.
- Jonah Summarized Jonah 2:9 But I will sacrifice unto thee with the voice of thanksgiving; I will pay that that I have vowed. Salvation is of the LORD.
- Numbers 30:3 If a woman also vow a vow unto the LORD, and bind herself by a bond, being in her father's house in her youth;
- 1 Corinthians 11:3 But I would have you know, that the head of every <u>man</u> is <u>Christ</u>; and the head of the woman *is* the <u>man</u>; and the head of <u>Christ</u> *is* God.
- 1 Timothy 2:14 And Adam was not <u>deceived</u>, but the <u>woman</u> being <u>deceived</u> was in the transgression.
- 1 Samuel 25 Summarized the account of Nabal & Abigail with David.
- Numbers 30:4-9 And her father hear her vow, and her bond wherewith she hath bound her soul, and her father shall hold his peace at her: then all her vows shall stand, and every bond wherewith she hath bound her soul shall stand. 5 But if her father disallow her in the day that he heareth; not any of her vows, or of her bonds wherewith she hath bound her soul, shall stand: and the LORD shall forgive her, because her father disallowed her. 6 And if she had at all an husband, when she vowed, or uttered ought out of her lips, wherewith she bound her soul; 7 And her husband heard it, and held his peace at her in the day that he heard it: then her vows shall stand, and her bonds wherewith she bound her soul shall stand. 8 But if her husband disallowed her on the day that he heard it; then he shall make her vow which she vowed, and that which she uttered with her lips, wherewith she bound her soul, of none effect: and the LORD shall forgive her. 9 But every vow of a widow, and of her that is divorced, wherewith they have bound their souls, shall stand against her.
- Deuteronomy 23:2 A bastard shall not enter into the congregation of the LORD; even to his tenth generation shall he not enter into the congregation of the LORD. (Curse of illegitimacy)
- Numbers 30:10-13 And if she vowed in her husband's house, or bound her soul by a bond with an oath; 11 And her husband heard it, and held his peace at her, and disallowed her not: then all her vows shall stand, and every bond wherewith she bound her soul shall stand. 12 But if her husband hath utterly made them void on the day he heard them; then whatsoever proceeded out of her lips concerning her vows, or concerning the bond of her soul, shall not stand: her husband hath made them void; and the LORD shall forgive her. 13 Every vow, and every binding oath to afflict the soul, her husband may establish it, or her

husband may make it void.

- 1 Timothy 2:9,10 In like manner also, that women adorn themselves in modest apparel, with shamefacedness and sobriety; not with broided hair, or gold, or pearls, or costly array; 10 But (which becometh women professing godliness) with good works.
- Numbers 30:14-16 But if her husband altogether hold his peace at her from day to day; then he establisheth all her vows, or all her bonds, which are upon her: he confirmeth them, because he held his peace at her in the day that he heard them. 15 But if he shall any ways make them void after that he hath heard them; then he shall bear her iniquity. 16 These are the statutes, which the LORD commanded Moses, between a man and his wife, between the father and his daughter, being yet in her youth in her father's house.
- Deuteronomy 11:18 Therefore shall ye <u>lay up these My words in your heart</u> and in your soul, and bind them for a sign upon your hand, that they may be as frontlets between your eyes.
- Matthew 23:5 But all their works they do for to be seen of men: they make broad their phylacteries, and enlarge the borders of their garments, (Jesus cursed the scribes and Pharisees for their hypocrisy.)
- 1 Samuel 25:29 (Abigail to David) Yet a man is risen to pursue thee, and to seek thy <u>soul</u>: but the <u>soul</u> of my lord (David) shall be <u>bound in the bundle of life with the LORD thy God</u>; and the <u>souls of thine enemies</u>, them shall He sling out, as out of the middle of a sling.
- Matthew 27:25 Then answered all the people, and said, His blood be on us, and on our children.
- John 19:15 But they cried out, Away with Him, away with Him, crucify Him. Pilate saith unto them, Shall I crucify your King? The chief priests answered, We have no king but Caesar.
- 2 Corinthians 6:14 Be ye not unequally yoked together with unbelievers: for what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? and what communion hath light with darkness?
- Galatians 5:1 Stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free, and be not entangled again with the <u>yoke</u> of bondage.
