## **Delivered From The Power of satan - Acts 26B**

Summarized the trials Paul has been through.

Acts 27:24 (the angel of God) Saying, Fear not, Paul; thou must be brought before Caesar: and, lo, God hath given thee all them that sail with thee.

1 Corinthians 9:22 To the weak became I as weak, that I might gain the weak: I am made all things to all *men*, that I might by all means save some.

Acts 17 Paul preached to the Athenians referred to.

Acts 26:12-23 Whereupon as I went to Damascus with authority and commission from the chief priests, 13 At midday, 0 king, I saw in the way a light from heaven, above the brightness of the sun, shining round about me and them which journeyed with me. 14 And when we were all fallen to the earth, I heard a voice speaking unto me, and saying in the Hebrew tongue, Saul, Saul, why persecutest thou me? it is hard for thee to kick against the pricks. 15 And I said, Who art thou, Lord? And he said, I am Jesus whom thou persecutest. 16 But rise, and stand upon thy feet: for I have appeared unto thee for this purpose, to make thee a minister and a witness both of these things which thou hast seen, and of those things in the which I will appear unto thee; 17 Delivering thee from the people, and from the Gentiles, unto whom now I send thee, 18 To open their eyes, and to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of satan unto God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins, and inheritance among them which are sanctified by faith that is in me. 19 Whereupon, O king Agrippa, I was not disobedient unto the heavenly vision: 20 But shewed first unto them of Damascus, and at Jerusalem, and throughout all the coasts of Judaea, and then to the Gentiles, that they should repent and turn to God, and do works meet for repentance. 21 For these causes the Jews caught me in the temple, and went about to kill me. 22 Having therefore obtained help of God, I continue unto this day, witnessing both to small and great, saying none other things than those which the prophets and Moses did say should come: 23 That Christ should suffer, and that he should be the first that should rise from the dead, and should shew light unto the people, and to the Gentiles.

1 Peter 3:15 But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts: and *be* <u>ready</u> always to *give* an answer to every man that asketh you a reason of the <u>hope</u> that is in you with meekness and fear:

- **Exodus 3 Moses at the burning bush fell on his face.**
- John 18:5,6 They answered him, <u>Jesus</u> of <u>Nazareth</u>. <u>Jesus</u> saith unto them, <u>I am</u> *he*. And Judas also, which betrayed him, stood with them. 6As soon then as he had said unto them, I am *he*, they went backward, and fell to the ground.
- Acts 26:15 And I said, Who art thou, Lord? And he said, I am Jesus whom thou persecutest.
- 1 John 3:8 He that committeth sin is of the devil; for the devil sinneth from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil.
- Acts 26:16,17 But rise, and stand upon thy feet: for I have appeared unto thee for this purpose, to make thee a minister and a witness both of these things which thou hast seen, and of those things in the which I will appear unto thee; 17 Delivering thee from the people, and from the Gentiles, unto whom now I send thee,
- 2 Corinthians 11 Paul's in perils list referred to.
- Acts 26:18 To open their eyes, and to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of satan unto God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins, and inheritance among them which are sanctified by faith that is in me.
- John 3:7 Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.
- Acts 17:30 And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commandeth all men every where to repent:
- Luke 10:2 Therefore said he unto them, The <u>harvest</u> truly *is* great, but the labourers *are* few: <u>pray</u> ye therefore the Lord of the <u>harvest</u>, that he would send forth labourers into his harvest.
- Galatians 3:11 But that no man is justified by the law in the sight of God, *it* is evident: for, The just shall live by faith.
- Galatians 2:8,9 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: *it is* the gift of God: 9 Not of works, lest any man should boast.
- Acts 26:19 Whereupon, O king Agrippa, I was not disobedient unto the heavenly vision: 20 But shewed first unto them of Damascus, and at Jerusalem, and throughout all the coasts of Judaea, and then to the

Gentiles, that they should <u>repent and turn to God, and do works meet for repentance</u>.

Matthew 3:2 And saying, Repent ye: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.

Acts 17:30 And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commandeth all men every where to <u>repent</u>:

Matthew 3:8 Bring forth therefore <u>fruits</u> meet for <u>repentance</u>:

- Acts 26:21 For these causes the Jews caught me in the temple, and went about to kill me. 22 Having therefore obtained help of God, I continue unto this day, witnessing both to small and great, saying none other things than those which the prophets and Moses did say should come: 23 That Christ should suffer, and that he should be the first that should rise from the dead, and should shew light unto the people, and to the Gentiles.
- Matthew 28:13 Saying, Say ye, His disciples came by <u>night</u>, and stole him *away* while we slept.
- John 21:1,2 After these things Jesus shewed himself again to the disciples at the sea of Tiberias; and on this wise shewed he *himself*. 2 There were together Simon Peter, and Thomas called Didymus, and Nathanael of Cana in Galilee, and the *sons* of Zebedee, and two other of his disciples. (7 witnesses 7 disciples)
- John 16:7 Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the <u>Comforter</u> will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will <u>send</u> him unto you.
- Matthew 24:22 And except those days should be shortened, there should no flesh be saved: but for the elect's sake those days shall be shortened.
- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have *it* more abundantly.
- Revelation 19:11-16 And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war. 12 His eyes were as a flame of fire, and on his head were many crowns; and he had a name written, that no man knew, but he himself. 13 And he was clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: and his name is called The Word of God. 14 And the armies which were in heaven followed him upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean. 15 And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God. 16 And he hath on his vesture and on his thigh a name written, KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS.

- Summarized the Lord's return & 1000 year rule from the Revelation.
- Revelation 12:11 Therefore rejoice, *ye* heavens, and ye that dwell in them. Woe to the inhabiters of the earth and of the sea! for the devil is come down unto you, having great wrath, because he knoweth that he hath but a short time.
- Revelation 20:11 And I saw a great white throne, and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them.
- John 1:3All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made. (Jesus the Word)
- Revelation 20:12 And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works.
- 2 Corinthians 6:2 (For he saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now *is* the accepted time; behold, now *is* the day of salvation.)
- Revelation 20:13,14 And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works. 14 And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death. 15 And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.
- Luke 16 Summarized the syory of Lazarus & the rich man.
- Romans 14:12 So then every one of us shall give account of himself to God.
- 2 Corinthians 4:1-4 Therefore seeing we have this ministry, as we have received mercy, we faint not; 2 But have renounced the hidden things of dishonesty, not walking in craftiness, nor handling the word of God deceitfully; but by manifestation of the truth commending ourselves to every man's conscience in the sight of God. 3 But if our gospel be hid, it is hid to them that are lost: 4 In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them. (Pray)
- Isaiah 6:9-10 And he said, Go, and tell this people, Hear ye indeed, but understand not; and see ye indeed, but perceive not. 10 Make the heart of this people fat, and make their ears heavy, and shut their eyes; lest they see with their eyes, and hear with their ears, and understand with their heart, and convert, and be healed. (Pray)
- Romans 10:9,10 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. 10For with the heart man believeth unto

- righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.
- 1 King 18:37 Hear me, O LORD, hear me, that this people may know that thou *art* the LORD God, and *that* thou hast turned their heart back again.
- John 6:28-29 Then said they unto him, What shall we do, that we might work the works of God? 29 Jesus answered and said unto them, This is the work of God, that ye believe on him whom he hath sent.
- John 20:31 But these are written, that ye might <u>believe</u> that Jesus is the Christ, the <u>Son</u> of <u>God</u>; and that <u>believing</u> ye might have life through his name.
- Philippians 2:12 Wherefore, my beloved, as ye have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, <u>work</u> out your own salvation with fear and trembling.
- Ephesians 4:30 And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are <u>sealed</u> unto the day of <u>redemption</u>.
- Matthew 26:56 But all this was done, that the scriptures of the prophets might be fulfilled. Then all the disciples forsook him, and fled.
- Luke 9:55 But he turned, and rebuked them, and said, Ye know not what manner of spirit ye are of. (the sons of thunder)
- Acts 8, 13, & 19 have deliverance examples in the New Church after the resurrection of Jesus.
- Many healings in the Gospel of Mark are from casting out demons.
- Matthew 10 & Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; Psalm 23:3A He restoreth my soul:

More Service notes:

2 Corinthians 4:5-7 For we preach not ourselves, but Christ Jesus the Lord; and ourselves your servants for Jesus' sake. 6 For God, who commanded the light to shine out of darkness, hath shined in our hearts, to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ. 7 But we have this treasure in earthen vessels, that the excellency of the power may be of God, and not of us.
