- 2 Corinthians 5:21 For He hath made Him *to be* sin for us, Who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in Him.
- 1 Peter 2:22 Who did no sin, neither was guile found in His mouth:
- 1 John 3:5 And ye know that He was manifested to take away our sins; and in Him is no sin.
- John 14:30 Hereafter I will not talk much with you: for the prince of this world cometh, and hath nothing in Me.
- Colossians 3:1-25 (AV) & (NKJV)
- Colossians 3:1 (AV) If ye then be risen with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ sitteth on the right hand of God.
- Colossians 3:1 (NKJV) If then you were raised with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ is, sitting at the right hand of God.
- 2 Corinthians 13:5 Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith; prove your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates?
- Acts 7:56 And (Stephen) said, Behold, I see the heavens opened, and the Son of Man standing on the right hand of God.
- Colossians 3:2 (AV) Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth.
- Colossians 3:2 (NKJV) Set your mind on things above, not on things on the earth.

- Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what *is* that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
- Colossians 3:3 (AV) For ye are dead, and your life is hid with Christ in God.
- Colossians 3:3 (NKJV) For you died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God.
- 2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore if any man *be* in Christ, *he is* a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.

- Revelation 19 Referred to Jesus' return & 1000 year rule.
- 1 Thessalonians 4:16 For the Lord Himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first:
- Colossians 3:5 (AV) Mortify therefore your members which are upon the earth; fornication, uncleanness, inordinate affection, evil concupiscence, and covetousness, which is idolatry:
- Colossians 3:5 (NKJV) Therefore put to death your members which are on the earth: fornication, uncleanness, passion, evil desire, and covetousness, which is idolatry.
- Ephesians 6:20 For which I am an ambassador in bonds: that therein I may speak boldly, as I ought to speak.
- Deuteronomy 16:19 Thou shalt not wrest judgment; thou shalt not respect persons, neither take a gift: for a gift doth blind the eyes of the wise, and pervert the Words of the righteous.

- Colossians 3:6 (AV) For which things' sake the wrath of God cometh on the children of disobedience:

- Psalms 23:3A He restoreth my soul.
- Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- Colossians 3:9 (AV) Lie not one to another, seeing that ye have put off the old man with his deeds;
- Colossians 3:9 (NKJV) Do not lie to one another, since you have put off the old man with his deeds,

- Colossians 3:10 (AV) And have put on the new *man*, which is renewed in knowledge after the image of Him that created Him:

- Colossians 3:11 (AV) Where there is neither Greek nor Jew, circumcision nor uncircumcision, Barbarian, Scythian, bond *nor* free: but Christ *is* all, and in all.
- Colossians 3:11 (NKJV) where there is neither Greek nor Jew, circumcised nor uncircumcised, barbarian, Scythian, slave *nor* free, but Christ *is* all and in all.
- Galatians 2:11-14 But when Peter was come to Antioch, I withstood him to the face, because he was to be blamed. 12 For before that certain came from James, he did eat with the Gentiles: but when they were come, he withdrew and separated himself, fearing them which were of the circumcision. 13 And the other Jews dissembled likewise with him; insomuch that Barnabas also was carried away with their dissimulation. 14 But when I saw that they walked not uprightly according to the truth of the gospel, I said unto Peter before them all, If thou, being a Jew, livest after the manner of Gentiles, and not as do the Jews, why compellest thou the Gentiles to live as do the Jews?
- Colossians 3:12 (AV) Put on therefore, as the elect of God, Holy and beloved, bowels of mercies, kindness, humbleness of mind, meekness, longsuffering;
- Colossians 3:12 (NKJV) Therefore, as *the* elect of God, Holy and beloved, put on tender mercies, kindness, humility, meekness, longsuffering;
- Revelation 17:14 These shall make war with the Lamb, and the Lamb shall overcome them: for He is Lord of lords, and King of kings: and they that are with Him *are* called, and chosen, and faithful.
- Romans 8:35,38,39 Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? 38 For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor

- powers, nor things present, nor things to come, 39 Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.
- Colossians 3:13 (AV) Forbearing one another, and forgiving one another, if any man have a quarrel against any: even as Christ forgave you, so also *do* ye.
- Colossians 3:13 (NKJV) bearing with one another, and forgiving one another, if anyone has a complaint against another; even as Christ forgave you, so you also *must do*.
- Matthew 18:21,22 Then came Peter to him, and said, Lord, how oft shall my brother sin against me, and I forgive him? till seven times? 22 Jesus saith unto him, I say not unto thee, Until seven times: but, Until seventy times seven.
- Colossians 3:14 (AV) And above all these things *put on* charity, which is the bond of perfectness.
- Colossians 3:14 (NKJV) But above all these things put on love, which is the bond of perfection.
- 1 Corinthians 13 Referred to God's love chapter. V13 And now abideth faith, hope, charity, these three; but the greatest of these *is* charity (love).
- Colossians 3:15 (AV) And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to the which also ye are called in one body; and be ye thankful.
- Colossians 3:15 (NKJV) And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to which also you were called in one body; and be thankful.
- Colossians 3:16 (AV) Let the Word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom; teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.
- Colossians 3:16 (NKJV) Let the Word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.
- Psalms 111:10 The fear of the LORD *is* the beginning of wisdom: a good understanding have all they that do *His* commandments: His praise endureth for ever.
- Colossians 3:8 (AV) But now ye also put off all these; anger,

- wrath, malice, blasphemy, filthy communication out of your mouth.
- Colossians 3:10 (AV) And have put on the new *man*, which is renewed in knowledge after the image of Him that created Him:

- Colossians 3:18 (AV) Wives, submit yourselves unto your own husbands, as it is fit in the Lord.
- Colossians 3:18 (NKJV) Wives, submit to your own husbands, as is fitting in the Lord.
- Colossians 3:19 (AV) Husbands, love *your* wives, and be not bitter against them.
- Colossians 3:19 (NKJV) Husbands, love your wives and do not be bitter toward them.
- Genesis 2:18 And the LORD God said, *It is* not good that the man should be alone; I will make him an help meet for him. 21 And the LORD God caused a deep sleep to fall upon Adam, and he slept: and he took one of his ribs, and closed up the flesh instead thereof; 22 And the rib, which the LORD God had taken from man, made he a woman, and brought her unto the man. 23 And Adam said, This *is* now bone of my bones, and flesh of my flesh: she shall be called Woman, because she was taken out of Man. 24 Therefore shall a man leave his father and his

- mother, and shall cleave unto his wife: and they shall be one flesh.
- Ephesians 5:25 Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave Himself for it;

- Mark 10:6-9 But from the beginning of the creation God made them male and female. 7 For this cause shall a man leave his father and mother, and cleave to his wife; 8 And they twain shall be one flesh: so then they are no more twain, but one flesh. 9 What therefore God hath joined together, let not man put asunder.
- Matthew 19:10-12 His disciples say unto Him, If the case of the man be so with *his* wife, it is not good to marry. 11 But He said unto them, All *men* cannot receive this saying, save *they* to whom it is given. 12 For there are some eunuchs, which were so born from *their* mother's womb: and there are some eunuchs, which were made eunuchs of men: and there be eunuchs, which have made themselves eunuchs for the kingdom of heaven's sake. He that is able to receive *it*, let him receive *it*.
- Colossians 3:20 (AV) Children, obey *your* parents in all things: for this is well pleasing unto the Lord.
- Colossians 3:20 (NKJV) Children, obey your parents in all things, for this is well pleasing to the Lord.
- Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.
- Colossians 3:21 (AV) Fathers, provoke not your children *to anger*, lest they be discouraged.
- Colossians 3:21 Fathers, do not provoke your children, lest they become discouraged.
- Colossians 3:22 (AV) Servants, obey in all things *your* masters according to the flesh; not with eyeservice, as menpleasers; but in singleness of heart, fearing God:
- Colossians 3:22 (NKJV) Bondservants, obey in all things your masters according to the flesh, not with eyeservice, as menpleasers, but in sincerity of heart, fearing God.

- Strongs #1401 doulos *doo'-los* AV-servant 120, bond 6, bondman 1; 127 1) a slave, bondman, man of servile condition 1a) a slave 1b) metaph., one who gives himself up to another's will, those whose service is used by Christ in extending and advancing his cause among men 1c) devoted to another to the disregard of one's own interests 2) a servant, attendant.
- Colossians 3:23 (AV) And whatsoever ye do, do *it* heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men;
- Colossians 3:23 (NKJV) And whatever you do, do it heartily, as to the Lord and not to men,
- Colossians 3:24 (AV) Knowing that of the Lord ye shall receive the reward of the inheritance: for ye serve the Lord Christ.
- Colossians 3:24 (NKJV) knowing that from the Lord you will receive the reward of the inheritance; for you serve the Lord Christ.
- Colossians 3:25 (AV) But he that doeth wrong shall receive for the wrong which he hath done: and there is no respect of persons.
- Colossians 3:25 (NKJV) But he who does wrong will be repaid for what he has done, and there is no partiality.
- Deuteronomy 16:19 Thou shalt not wrest judgment; thou shalt not respect persons, neither take a gift: for a gift doth blind the eyes of the wise, and pervert the words of the righteous.
- Isaiah 1:26 And I will restore thy judges as at the first, and thy counsellors as at the beginning: afterward thou shalt be called, The city of righteousness, the faithful city.
