The Glory Of God – Exodus 24:17

- Exodus 16:17 And the sight of the Glory of the LORD *was* like devouring fire on the top of the mount in the eyes of the children of Israel.
- Matthew 12:33 Either make the tree good, and his fruit good; or else make the tree corrupt, and his fruit corrupt: for the tree is known by his fruit.
- Exodus 16:7 And in the morning, then ye shall see the Glory of the LORD; for that He heareth your murmurings against the LORD: and what *are* we, that ye murmur against us?
- Exodus 16:10 And it came to pass, as Aaron spake unto the whole congregation of the children of Israel, that they looked toward the wilderness, and, behold, the Glory of the LORD appeared in the cloud.
- Ezekiel 1:26-28 Similar to Ezekiel's first vision of God.
- Exodus 24:16,17 And the Glory of the LORD abode upon mount Sinai, and the cloud covered it six days: and the seventh day He called unto Moses out of the midst of the cloud. 17 And the sight of the Glory of the LORD was like devouring fire on the top of the mount in the eyes of the children of Israel.
- Exodus 20:19 And they said unto Moses, Speak thou with us, and we will hear: but let not God speak with us, lest we die.
- Exodus 40:34,35 Then a cloud covered the tent of the congregation, and the Glory of the LORD filled the tabernacle. 35 And Moses was not able to enter into the tent of the congregation, because the cloud abode thereon, and the Glory of the LORD filled the tabernacle.
- Leviticus 9:6 And Moses said, This *is* the thing which the LORD commanded that ye should do: and the Glory of the LORD shall appear unto you.
- Leviticus 9:23 And Moses and Aaron went into the tabernacle of the congregation, and came out, and blessed the people: and the Glory of the LORD appeared unto all the people.
- Numbers 14:10 But all the congregation bade stone them with stones. And the Glory of the LORD appeared in the tabernacle

- of the congregation before all the children of Israel.
- Numbers 14:21 But as truly as I live, all the earth shall be filled with the Glory of the LORD.
- Numbers 16:19 And Korah gathered all the congregation against them unto the door of the tabernacle of the congregation: and the Glory of the LORD appeared unto all the congregation.
- Numbers 16:42 And it came to pass, when the congregation was gathered against Moses and against Aaron, that they looked toward the tabernacle of the congregation: and, behold, the cloud covered it, and the Glory of the LORD appeared.
- Numbers 20:6 And Moses and Aaron went from the presence of the assembly unto the door of the tabernacle of the congregation, and they fell upon their faces: and the Glory of the LORD appeared unto them.
- 1 Kings 8:11 So that the priests could not stand to minister because of the cloud: for the Glory of the LORD had filled the house of the LORD.
- 2 Chronicles 5:14 So that the priests could not stand to minister by reason of the cloud: for the Glory of the LORD had filled the house of God.
- 2 Chronicles 7:1-3 Now when Solomon had made an end of praying, the fire came down from heaven, and consumed the burnt offering and the sacrifices; and the Glory of the LORD filled the house. 2 And the priests could not enter into the house of the LORD, because the Glory of the LORD had filled the LORD'S house. 3 And when all the children of Israel saw how the fire came down, and the Glory of the LORD upon the house, they bowed themselves with their faces to the ground upon the pavement, and worshipped, and praised the LORD, saying, For He is good; for His mercy endureth for ever.
- 1 Kings 18:38 Then the fire of the LORD fell, and consumed the burnt sacrifice, and the wood, and the stones, and the dust, and licked up the water that was in the trench.
- Psalms 104:31 The Glory of the LORD shall endure for ever: the LORD shall rejoice in His works.
- Psalms 138:5 Yea, they shall sing in the ways of the LORD: for great *is* the Glory of the LORD.
- Isaiah 35:2 It shall blossom abundantly, and rejoice even with joy

- and singing: the Glory of Lebanon shall be given unto it, the excellency of Carmel and Sharon, they shall see the Glory of the LORD, *and* the excellency of our God.
- Isaiah 40:5 And the Glory of the LORD shall be revealed, and all flesh shall see *it* together: for the Mouth of the LORD hath Spoken *it*.
- Revelation 20:4 And I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and judgment was given unto them: and I saw the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Jesus, and for the Word of God, and which had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, neither had received his mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands; and they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years.
- Isaiah 58:8 Then shall thy light break forth as the morning, and thine health shall spring forth speedily: and thy righteousness shall go before thee; the Glory of the LORD shall be thy Rereward.
- Isaiah 60:1 Arise, shine; for thy light is come, and the Glory of the LORD is risen upon thee.
- Ezekiel 1:28 As the appearance of the bow that is in the cloud in the day of rain, so was the appearance of the brightness round about. This was the appearance of the likeness of the Glory of the LORD. And when I saw it, I fell upon my face, and I heard a Voice of one that spake.
- Ezekiel 3:12 Then the spirit took me up, and I heard behind me a Voice of a great rushing, *saying*, Blessed *be* the Glory of the LORD from His place.
- Ezekiel 3:23 Then I arose, and went forth into the plain: and, behold, the Glory of the LORD stood there, as the Glory which I saw by the river of Chebar: and I fell on my face.
- Ezekiel 10:4 Then the Glory of the LORD went up from the cherub, and stood over the threshold of the house; and the house was filled with the cloud, and the court was full of the brightness of the LORD'S Glory.
- Ezekiel 10:18 Then the Glory of the LORD departed from off the threshold of the house, and stood over the cherubims.
- Josephus mentioned that it was heard "Let Us depart" before Jerusalem was destroyed in 70AD.

- Ezekiel 11:23 And the Glory of the LORD went up from the midst of the city, and stood upon the mountain which *is* on the east side of the city.
- Ezekiel 43:4,5 And the Glory of the LORD came into the house by the way of the gate whose prospect *is* toward the east. 5 So the Spirit took me up, and brought me into the inner court; and, behold, the Glory of the LORD filled the house.
- Ezekiel 44:4 Then brought he me the way of the north gate before the house: and I looked, and, behold, the Glory of the LORD filled the house of the LORD: and I fell upon my face.
- Habakkuk 2:14 For the earth shall be filled with the knowledge of the Glory of the LORD, as the waters cover the sea.
- Luke 2:9-11 And, lo, the angel of the Lord came upon them, and the Glory of the Lord shone round about them: and they were sore afraid. 10 And the angel said unto them, Fear not: for, behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy, which shall be to all people. 11 For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Saviour, which is Christ the Lord.
- 2 Corinthians 3:18 But we all, with open face beholding as in a glass the Glory of the Lord, are changed into the same image from Glory to Glory, *even* as by the Spirit of the Lord.
- Mark 9:1-3 And He said unto them, Verily I say unto you, That there be some of them that stand here, which shall not taste of death, till they have seen the kingdom of God come with power. 2 And after six days Jesus taketh with Him Peter, and James, and John, and leadeth them up into an high mountain apart by themselves: and He was transfigured before them. 3 And His raiment became shining (The Glory of God shining through), exceeding white as snow; so as no fuller on earth can white them.
- Referred to many times Jesus appeared preincarnate in the Old Testament.
- Mark 9:4-7 And there appeared unto them Elias with Moses: and they were talking with Jesus. 5 And Peter answered and said to Jesus, Master, it is good for us to be here: and let us make three tabernacles; one for Thee, and one for Moses, and one for Elias. 6 For he wist not what to say; for they were sore afraid. 7 And there was a cloud that overshadowed them: and

- a Voice came out of the cloud, saying, This is My beloved Son: hear Him.
- Luke 3:22 And the Holy Ghost descended in a bodily shape like a dove upon Him, and a Voice came from heaven, which said, Thou art My beloved Son; in Thee I am well pleased.
- Strongs #191 akouo ak-oo'-o AV-hear 418, hearken 6, give audience 3, hearer 2, misc 8; 437 1) to be endowed with the faculty of hearing, not deaf 2) to hear 2b) to attend to, consider what is or has been said 2c) to understand, perceive the sense of what is said 3) to hear something 3a) to perceive by the ear what is announced in one's presence 3b) to get by hearing learn 3c) a thing comes to one's ears, to find out, learn 3d) to give ear to a teaching or a teacher 3e) to comprehend, to understand.
- Mark 9:8,9 And suddenly, when they had looked round about, they saw no man any more, save Jesus only with themselves. 9 And as they came down from the mountain, He charged them that they should tell no man what things they had seen, till the Son of Man were risen from the dead.
- Ezekiel 1:26-28 And above the firmament that was over their heads was the likeness of a throne, as the appearance of a sapphire stone: and upon the likeness of the throne was the likeness as the appearance of a Man above upon it. 27 And I saw as the colour of amber, as the appearance of fire round about within it, from the appearance of His loins even upward, and from the appearance of His loins even downward, I saw as it were the appearance of fire, and it had brightness round about. 28 As the appearance of the bow that is in the cloud in the day of rain, so was the appearance of the brightness round about. This was the appearance of the likeness of the Glory of the LORD. And when I saw it, I fell upon my face, and I heard a Voice of one that spake.
- Ezekiel 2:1-10 And He said unto me, Son of man, stand upon thy feet, and I will speak unto thee. 2 And the Spirit entered into me when He spake unto me, and set me upon my feet, that I heard Him that spake unto me. 3 And He said unto me, Son of man, I send thee to the children of Israel, to a rebellious nation that hath rebelled against Me: they and their fathers

have transgressed against Me, even unto this very day. 4 For they are impudent children and stiffhearted. I do send thee unto them; and thou shalt say unto them, Thus saith the Lord GOD. 5 And they, whether they will hear, or whether they will forbear, (for they *are* a rebellious house,) yet shall know that there hath been a prophet among them. 6 And thou, son of man, be not afraid of them, neither be afraid of their words, though briers and thorns be with thee, and thou dost dwell among scorpions: be not afraid of their words, nor be dismayed at their looks, though they be a rebellious house. 7 And thou shalt speak My Words unto them, whether they will hear, or whether they will forbear: for they are most rebellious. 8 But thou, son of man, hear what I say unto thee; Be not thou rebellious like that rebellious house: open thy mouth, and eat that I give thee. 9 And when I looked, behold, an hand was sent unto me; and, lo, a roll of a book was therein; 10 And He spread it before me; and it was written within and without: and there was written therein lamentations, and mourning, and woe.

Isaiah 6:1 In the year that king Uzziah died I saw also the Lord sitting upon a throne, high and lifted up, and His train filled the temple.

Revelation 1:10-20 I was in the Spirit on the Lord's day, and heard behind me a great Voice, as of a trumpet, 11 Saying, I am Alpha and Omega, the First and the Last: and, What thou seest, write in a book, and send *it* unto the seven churches which are in Asia; unto Ephesus, and unto Smyrna, and unto Pergamos, and unto Thyatira, and unto Sardis, and unto Philadelphia, and unto Laodicea. 12 And I turned to see the Voice that spake with me. And being turned, I saw seven golden candlesticks; 13 And in the midst of the seven candlesticks *one* like unto the Son of Man, clothed with a garment down to the foot, and girt about the paps with a golden girdle. 14 His head and *His* hairs *were* white like wool, as white as snow; and His eyes *were* as a flame of fire; 15 And His feet like unto fine brass, as if they burned in a furnace; and His Voice as the sound of many waters. 16 And He had in His right hand seven stars: and out of His mouth went a sharp

twoedged sword: and His countenance was as the sun shineth in his strength. 17 And when I saw Him, I fell at His feet as dead. And He laid His right hand upon me, saying unto me, Fear not; I am the First and the Last: 18 I am He that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive for evermore, Amen; and have the keys of hell and of death. 19 Write the things which thou hast seen, and the things which are, and the things which shall be hereafter; 20 The mystery of the seven stars which thou sawest in My right hand, and the seven golden candlesticks. The seven stars are the angels of the seven churches: and the seven candlesticks which thou sawest are the seven churches.

- Ezekiel 9:3 And the Glory of the God of Israel was gone up from the cherub, whereupon He was, to the threshold of the house. And He called to the man clothed with linen, which had the writer's inkhorn by his side;
- Ezekiel 11:23 And the Glory of the LORD went up from the midst of the city, and stood upon the mountain which is on the east side of the city.
- Exodus 34:29-35 And it came to pass, when Moses came down from mount Sinai with the two tables of testimony in Moses' hand, when he came down from the mount, that Moses wist not that the skin of his face shone while he talked with him. 30 And when Aaron and all the children of Israel saw Moses. behold, the skin of his face shone; and they were afraid to come nigh him. 31 And Moses called unto them; and Aaron and all the rulers of the congregation returned unto him: and Moses talked with them. 32 And afterward all the children of Israel came nigh: and he gave them in commandment all that the LORD had spoken with him in mount Sinai. 33 And till Moses had done speaking with them, he put a vail on his face. 34 But when Moses went in before the LORD to speak with him, he took the vail off, until he came out. And he came out, and spake unto the children of Israel that which he was commanded. 35 And the children of Israel saw the face of Moses, that the skin of Moses' face shone: and Moses put the vail upon his face again, until he went in to speak with him.

Revelation 19:11-16 And I saw heaven opened, and behold a

white horse; and He that sat upon him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He doth judge and make war. 12 His eyes were as a flame of fire, and on His head were many crowns; and He had a name written, that no man knew, but He Himself. 13 And He was clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: and His Name is called The Word of God. 14 And the armies which were in heaven followed Him upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean. 15 And out of His mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it He should smite the nations: and He shall rule them with a rod of iron: and He treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God. 16 And He hath on His vesture and on His thigh a Name written, KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS.

Referred to that God had sent lots of prophets to His people.

Exodus 8:1 And the LORD spake unto Moses, Go unto Pharaoh,
and say unto him, Thus saith the LORD, Let My people go, that
they may serve Me.

Exodus 19:6 And ye shall be unto Me a kingdom of priests, and an Holy nation. These are the Words which thou shalt speak unto the children of Israel.

Revelation 1:6 And hath made us kings and priests unto God and His Father; to Him be Glory and dominion for ever and ever.

Amen.
