## 2024 - The Spirit of Violence - Genesis 6

- Genesis 6:11-13 The earth also was corrupt before God, and the earth was filled with violence. 12 So God looked upon the earth, and indeed it was corrupt; for all flesh had corrupted their way on the earth. 13 And God said unto Noah, The end of all flesh is come before Me; for the earth is filled with violence through them; and, behold, I will destroy them with the earth.

- Genesis 6:11,13 The earth also was corrupt before God, and the earth was filled with violence (02555). 13 And God said unto Noah, The end of all flesh is come before Me; for the earth is filled with violence (02555) through them; and, behold, I will destroy them with the earth.
- Genesis 16:5 And Sarai said unto Abram, My wrong (02555) be upon thee: I have given my maid into thy bosom; and when she saw that she had conceived, I was despised in her eyes: the LORD judge between me and thee.
- Genesis 49:5 Simeon and Levi *are* brethren; instruments of cruelty (02555) *are in* their habitations.
- Exodus 23:1 Thou shalt not raise a false report: put not thine hand with the wicked to be an unrighteous (02555) witness.
- Deuteronomy 19:16 If a false (02555) witness rise up against any man

- to testify against him that which is wrong;
- Judges 9:24 That the cruelty (02555) *done* to the threescore and ten sons of Jerubbaal might come, and their blood be laid upon Abimelech their brother, which slew them; and upon the men of Shechem, which aided him in the killing of his brethren.
- 2 Samuel 22:3 The God of my rock; in Him will I trust: *He is* my shield, and the horn of my salvation, my high tower, and my refuge, my saviour; Thou savest me from violence (02555).
- 2 Samuel 22:49 And that bringeth me forth from mine enemies: Thou also hast lifted me up on high above them that rose up against me: thou hast delivered me from the violent (02555) man.
- 1 Chronicles 12:17 And David went out to meet them, and answered and said unto them, If ye be come peaceably unto me to help me, mine heart shall be knit unto you: but if *ye be come* to betray me to mine enemies, seeing *there is* no wrong (02555) in mine hands, the God of our fathers look *thereon*, and rebuke *it*.
- Job 16:17 Not for *any* injustice (02555) in mine hands: also my prayer *is* pure.
- Job 19:7 Behold, I cry out of wrong (02555), but I am not heard: I cry aloud, but *there is* no judgment.
- Psalms 7:16 His mischief shall return upon his own head, and his violent (02555) dealing shall come down upon his own pate.
- Psalms 11:5 The LORD trieth the righteous: but the wicked and him that loveth violence (02555) His Soul hateth.
- Psalms 18:48 He delivereth me from mine enemies: yea, Thou liftest me up above those that rise up against me: Thou hast delivered me from the violent (02555) man.
- Psalms 25:19 Consider mine enemies; for they are many; and they hate me with cruel (02555) hatred.
- Psalms 27:12 Deliver me not over unto the will of mine enemies: for false witnesses are risen up against me, and such as breathe out cruelty (02555).
- Psalms 35:11 False (02555) witnesses did rise up; they laid to my charge *things* that I knew not.
- Psalms 55:9 Destroy, O Lord, *and* divide their tongues: for I have seen violence (02555) and strife in the city.
- Psalms 58:2 Yea, in heart ye work wickedness; ye weigh the violence (02555) of your hands in the earth.

- Psalms 72:14 He shall redeem their soul from deceit and violence (02555): and precious shall their blood be in His sight.
- Psalms 73:6 Therefore pride compasseth them about as a chain; violence (02555) covereth them as a garment.
- Psalms 74:20 Have respect unto the covenant: for the dark places of the earth are full of the habitations of cruelty (02555).
- Psalms 140:1,4 «To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David.» Deliver me, O LORD, from the evil man: preserve me from the violent (02555) man; 4 Keep me, O LORD, from the hands of the wicked; preserve me from the violent (02555) man; who have purposed to overthrow my goings.
- Psalms 140:11 Let not an evil speaker be established in the earth: evil shall hunt the violent (02555) man to overthrow *him*.
- Proverbs 3:31 Envy thou not the oppressor (02555), and choose none of his ways.
- Proverbs 4:17 For they eat the bread of wickedness, and drink the wine of violence (02555).
- Proverbs 10:6 Blessings *are* upon the head of the just: but violence (02555) covereth the mouth of the wicked.
- Proverbs 10:11 The mouth of a righteous *man is* a well of life: but violence (02555) covereth the mouth of the wicked.
- Proverbs 13:2 A man shall eat good by the fruit of *his* mouth: but the soul of the transgressors *shall eat* violence (02555).
- Proverbs 16:29 A violent (02555) man enticeth his neighbour, and leadeth him into the way *that is* not good.
- Proverbs 26:6 He that sendeth a message by the hand of a fool cutteth off the feet, *and* drinketh damage (02555).
- Isaiah 53:9 And He made His grave with the wicked, and with the rich in His death; because He had done no violence (02555), neither was any deceit in His mouth.
- Isaiah 59:6 Their webs shall not become garments, neither shall they cover themselves with their works: their works *are* works of iniquity, and the act of violence (02555) *is* in their hands.
- Isaiah 60:18 Violence (02555) shall no more be heard in thy land, wasting nor destruction within thy borders; but thou shalt call thy walls Salvation, and thy gates Praise.
- Jeremiah 6:7 As a fountain casteth out her waters, so she casteth out her wickedness: violence (02555) and spoil is heard in her; before

- me continually is grief and wounds.
- Jeremiah 20:8 For since I spake, I cried out, I cried violence (02555) and spoil; because the Word of the LORD was made a reproach unto me, and a derision, daily.
- Jeremiah 51:35 The violence (02555) done to me and to my flesh *be* upon Babylon, shall the inhabitant of Zion say; and my blood upon the inhabitants of Chaldea, shall Jerusalem say.
- Jeremiah 51:46 And lest your heart faint, and ye fear for the rumour that shall be heard in the land; a rumour shall both come *one* year, and after that in *another* year *shall come* a rumour, and violence (02555) in the land, ruler against ruler.
- Ezekiel 7:11 Violence (02555) is risen up into a rod of wickedness: none of them *shall remain*, nor of their multitude, nor of any of theirs: neither *shall there be* wailing for them.
- Ezekiel 7:23 Make a chain: for the land is full of bloody crimes, and the city is full of violence (02555).
- Ezekiel 8:17 Then He said unto me, Hast thou seen *this*, O son of man? Is it a light thing to the house of Judah that they commit the abominations which they commit here? for they have filled the land with violence (02555), and have returned to provoke Me to anger: and, lo, they put the branch to their nose.
- Ezekiel 12:19 And say unto the people of the land, Thus saith the Lord GOD of the inhabitants of Jerusalem, and of the land of Israel; They shall eat their bread with carefulness, and drink their water with astonishment, that her land may be desolate from all that is therein, because of the violence (02555) of all them that dwell therein.
- Ezekiel 28:16 By the multitude of thy merchandise they have filled the midst of thee with violence (02555), and thou hast sinned: therefore I will cast thee as profane out of the mountain of God: and I will destroy thee, O covering cherub, from the midst of the stones of fire.
- Ezekiel 45:9 Thus saith the Lord GOD; Let it suffice you, O princes of Israel: remove violence (02555) and spoil, and execute judgment and justice, take away your exactions from My people, saith the Lord GOD.
- Joel 3:19 Egypt shall be a desolation, and Edom shall be a desolate wilderness, for the violence (02555) *against* the children of Judah, because they have shed innocent blood in their land.

- Amos 3:10 For they know not to do right, saith the LORD, who store up violence (02555) and robbery in their palaces.
- Amos 6:3 Ye that put far away the evil day, and cause the seat of violence (02555) to come near;
- Obadiah 1:10 For *thy* violence (02555) against thy brother Jacob shame shall cover thee, and thou shalt be cut off for ever.
- Jonah 3:8 But let man and beast be covered with sackcloth, and cry mightily unto God: yea, let them turn every one from his evil way, and from the violence (02555) that *is* in their hands.
- Micah 6:12 For the rich men thereof are full of violence (02555), and the inhabitants thereof have spoken lies, and their tongue *is* deceitful in their mouth.
- Habakkuk 1:2,3 O LORD, how long shall I cry, and Thou wilt not hear! even cry out unto Thee of violence (02555), and Thou wilt not save! 3 Why dost Thou shew me iniquity, and cause me to behold grievance? for spoiling and violence (02555) are before me: and there are that raise up strife and contention.
- Habakkuk 1:9 They shall come all for violence (02555): their faces shall sup up *as* the east wind, and they shall gather the captivity as the sand.
- Habakkuk 2:8 Because thou hast spoiled many nations, all the remnant of the people shall spoil thee; because of men's blood, and *for* the violence (02555) of the land, of the city, and of all that dwell therein.
- Habakkuk 2:17 For the violence (02555) of Lebanon shall cover thee, and the spoil of beasts, *which* made them afraid, because of men's blood, and for the violence (02555) of the land, of the city, and of all that dwell therein.
- Zephaniah 1:9 In the same day also will I punish all those that leap on the threshold, which fill their masters' houses with violence (02555) and deceit.
- Malachi 2:16 For the LORD, the God of Israel, saith that He hateth putting away: for *one* covereth violence (02555) with his garment, saith the LORD of hosts: therefore take heed to your spirit, that ye deal not treacherously.
- Strongs #971 biazo *bee-ad'-zo* AV suffer violence 1, press 1; 2 1) to use force, to apply force 2) to force, inflict violence on.

- Matthew 8:32 And he said unto them, Go. And when they were come out, they went into the herd of swine: and, behold, the whole herd of swine ran violently down a steep place into the sea, and perished in the waters.
- Matthew 11:12 And from the days of John the Baptist until now the kingdom of heaven suffereth violence, and the violent take it by force.
- Mark 5:13 And forthwith Jesus gave them leave. And the unclean spirits went out, and entered into the swine: and the herd ran violently down a steep place into the sea, (they were about two thousand;) and were choked in the sea.
- Luke 3:14 And the soldiers likewise demanded of him, saying, And what shall we do? And he said unto them, Do violence to no man, neither accuse *any* falsely; and be content with your wages.
- Luke 8:33 Then went the devils out of the man, and entered into the swine: and the herd ran violently down a steep place into the lake, and were choked.
- Acts 5:26 Then went the captain with the officers, and brought them without violence: for they feared the people, lest they should have been stoned.
- Acts 21:35 And when he came upon the stairs, so it was, that he was borne of the soldiers for the violence of the people.
- Acts 24:7 But the chief captain Lysias came *upon us*, and with great violence took *him* away out of our hands,
- Acts 27:41 And falling into a place where two seas met, they ran the ship aground; and the forepart stuck fast, and remained unmoveable, but the hinder part was broken with the violence of the waves.
- Hebrews 11:34 Quenched the violence of fire, escaped the edge of the sword, out of weakness were made strong, waxed valiant in fight, turned to flight the armies of the aliens.
- Revelation 18:21 And a mighty angel took up a stone like a great millstone, and cast *it* into the sea, saying, Thus with violence shall that great city Babylon be thrown down, and shall be found no more at all.
